

In today's Gospel, the laborers in the vineyard all received the same wage, even though some worked only one hour. Those who toiled all day were upset by what they considered to be an injustice. The parable seems to be addressed to the Jewish people who were upset because Jesus was implying that salvation was open to those who were not Jewish. After all, the Jews were the ones who had been trying to keep God's Commandments. Why should those who didn't even know the Commandments experience any reward?

Pope Benedict, in his book "Co-Workers of the Truth" addressed the question of this seeming injustice on God's part. This is how he put it:

"When we raise the question about the foundation and meaning of our Christian existence, there slips in a certain false hankering for the apparently more comfortable life of other people who are also going to heaven. We are too much like the laborers of the first hour in the parable of the workers in the vineyard (Mt. 20:1-16). Once they discovered that they could have earned their day's pay of one denarius in a much easier way, they could not understand why they had to labor the whole day. But what a strange attitude it is to find the duties of our Christian life unrewarding just because the denarius of salvation can be gained without them! It would seem that we – like the workers of the first hour – want to be paid not only with our own salvation, but more particularly with others' lack of salvation. That is at once very human and profoundly un-Christian."

If you are tempted to say that the landowner in the parable is not just – because those who labored all day in the hot sun should have gotten more than those who stood around all day in the marketplace – then let me challenge a basic assumption: Are you sure that it is really a bigger burden to labor all day, expecting a fair wage, than it is to be unemployed, not knowing whether there will be anything at all at the end of the day? Physical toil is certainly not the only form of suffering. Is it not possible that those who were hired at the last hour in fact bore a heavier burden – the anxiety of having to provide for their families?

I would suggest that we needn't be saddened when we see the wealth and the apparent ease of the life of those who are not laboring in the vineyard — in other words, the ones who don't seem to have to follow all the "rules" that we have to "put up with." Such a life is never what it appears. Such a life is not the secret to happiness. Such people usually struggle with fears and anxieties that people of faith don't experience.

Laboring in God's vineyard can be challenging at times, of course. But let us not suppose that those who do not know whether or not there will be a reward at the end have an easier life. Rather, let us pray that they will join us — at whatever stage in their life— to share in the rewards of God's Kingdom.
