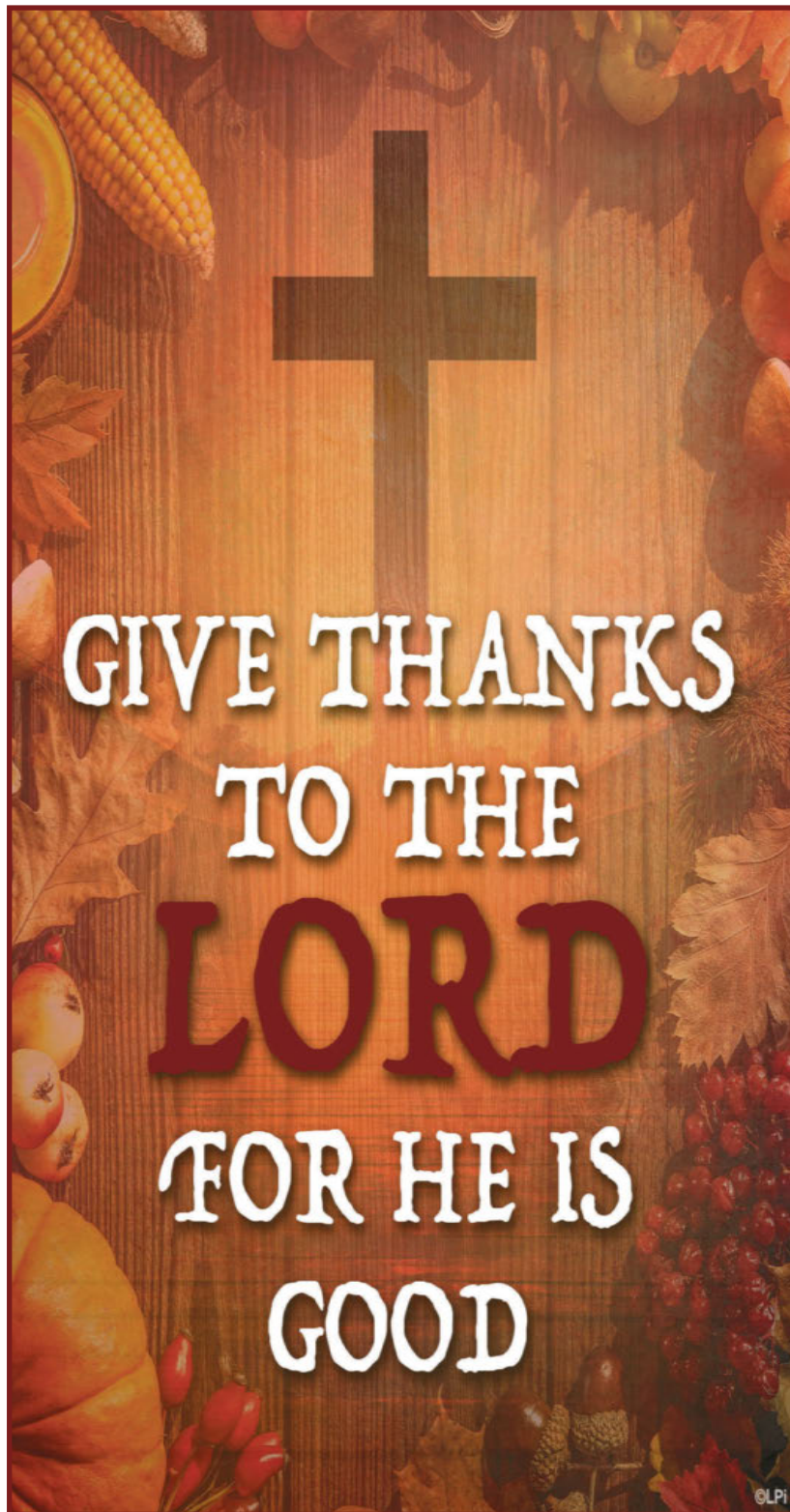

Fr. Dan Hoehn – FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



You may have noticed an additional deacon at our weekend celebrations here at St Mike's.

Deacon Roger Kyaw Thu, S.V.D., is a "transitional" deacon who is affiliated with a missionary religious order known as the "Society of the Divine Word". A transitional deacon (as opposed to a permanent deacon), is one who will be ordained to the priesthood. In Deacon Roger's case, that will happen this May, God, willing. His religious order wanted him to get some experience in a suburban parish, and so Deacon Roger will be with us during the weekends until May, after which time he will return to his native diocese in Myanmar. Below is a little biographical information about Deacon Roger.

I was encouraged to share a bit of who I am and as an 'introvert' this was a bit challenging. Yet I also have a desire for you to get to know me, and possibly address some questions you may be wondering about me and why I am here at St. Michael Parish.

I was born and raised in the country of Myanmar, formerly known as 'Burma' and located in Southeast Asia. I have two sisters, four brothers and am the second oldest of my siblings. All my biological family members still reside in Myanmar and the 'family' I have here in Chicago, is my religious community.

My favorite memory growing up was that we always gathered as a family for meals. It was a priority to be together for meals and this might be why I feel attracted to community life.

When I was younger, I heard inspiring stories about priests from my parents at a very young age. They tried to convince me to become a priest when I grew up. However, at the time, I did not have any interest in pursuing this ministry.

The first time I recall thinking about the priesthood, was when I was in the seventh grade. At this time, I was at a boarding school in my parish. I closely witnessed my pastor living out his priesthood. Witnessing his beautiful journey had a profound effect upon me.

I began to actively pray for a vocation to the priesthood. Sure enough, one day I received a sign from my associate pastor when he approached me and asked if I wanted to join the minor seminary. I trusted in God, and here I am.

In 2014, the Divine Word College in Epworth, IA, offered two scholarships in my home Diocese of Loikaw. I happened to be one of the two individuals chosen, to have the opportunity to study at the Divine Word College at Hyde Park in Chicago. After two years at the college, and with the permission and blessing of my Bishop, I was accepted to join the lifestyle of a missionary at the Society of the Divine Word.

In May, 2018, I finished my philosophical and intercultural studies. Then, I entered our novitiate in July 2018 which is at Northbrook, IL. This was followed by professing my temporal vows in August, 2019 and I began my theological study at the Catholic Theological Union in the fall of 2019, while residing at the Divine Word Theologate in Hyde Park in Chicago.

This was followed by taking my Perpetual Vows with four other classmates last September. Then I was ordained as a transitional deacon on October 1st. Currently I am in my final year of training.

I am pleased to be at St. Michael Parish until May of 2024 and anticipating being ordained to the priesthood on May 25, 2024 at the Church of the Holy Family in Chicago.

After ordination, I have been assigned to the Australian Province that includes Australia, New Zealand, Thailand, and Myanmar. It is very likely that I will be assigned to Myanmar since the province has just established a new mission in Myanmar. Yet, I am open to where God wishes me to be.

One of the biggest challenges for me during my training, is that I have not been able to visit with my biological family since transferring here to the US in 2014 due to Covid-19 and the political unrest in my country. Although, the hospitality from the communities and families I have stayed with, have tremendously eased my homesickness and been of essential support to me.

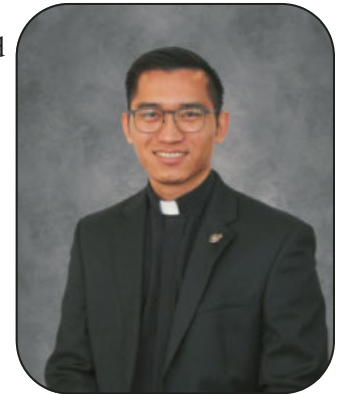
To be honest, I have wondered if this vocation is really for me, since I am such a shy and timid person. The US culture and the formation I received, have helped me in facing my shyness.

I have been attracted to the pastoral and teaching ministry. However, as a missionary, I must be open to any kind of ministry that my religious community calls for me to do. I have a strong desire to learn and be open to discerning what God is calling me to do. I have noticed, that I thrive when I feel a sense of belonging to a community.

I have been exposed to so many things since being in this country and have an interest in psychology and technology. I find the mystery of the human mind and human development to be very fascinating. I also like playing soccer and volleyball. I am eager to collecting information on any variety of different topics and challenging myself to learn something new.

Since being here with St. Michaels, I have felt a unique closeness to this community and look forward to be of service to the wonderful parishioners here.

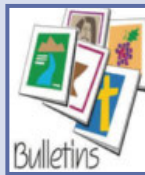
