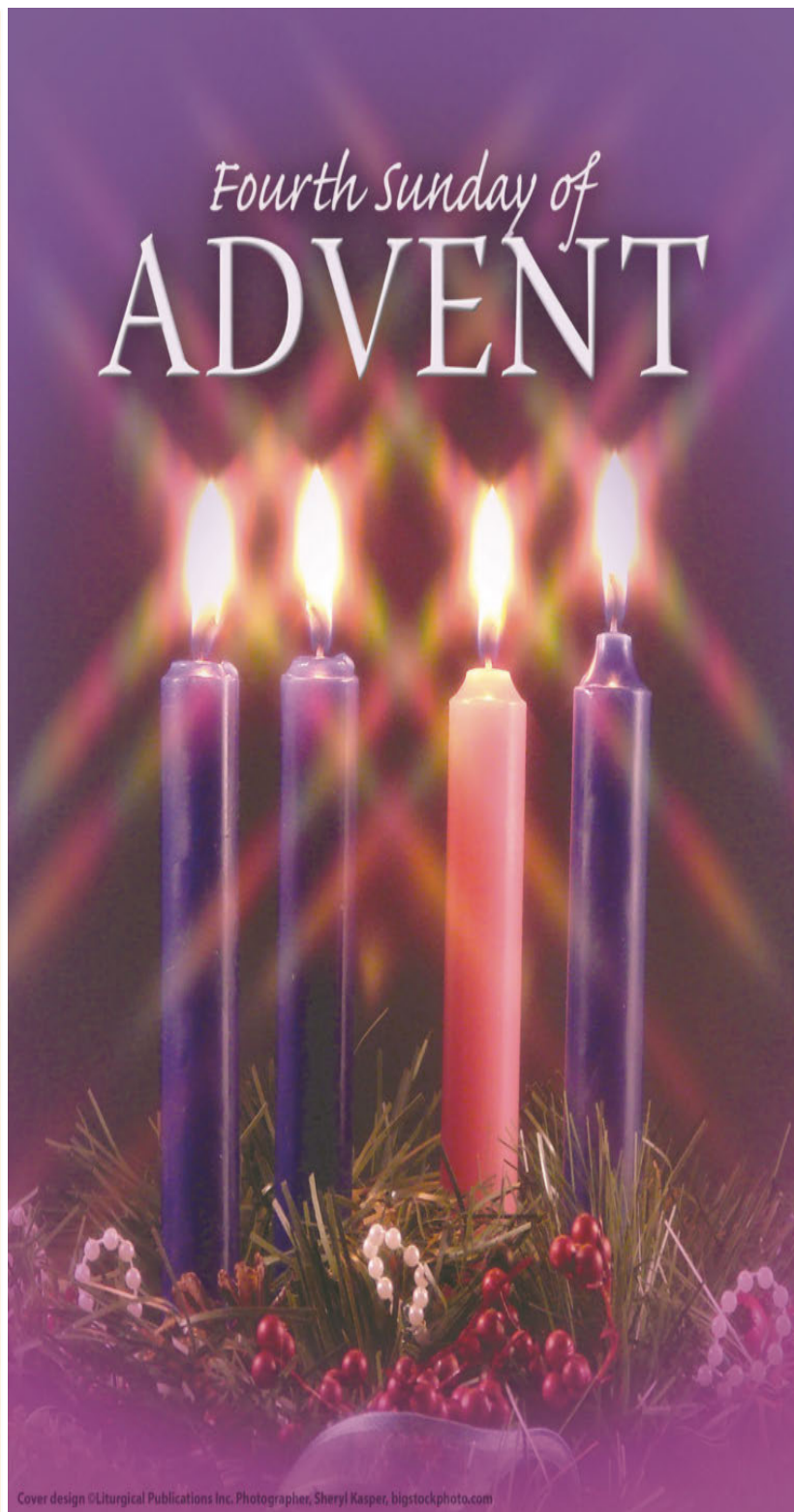

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On this final Sunday of Advent, today's liturgy presents us with Luke's account of the *Annunciation*— the angel Gabriel's announcement to Mary that she would be the Mother of God.

I am struck by Mary's promptness in responding to the angel: "Let it be done to me according to your word."


