
The 2024 Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal has begun!

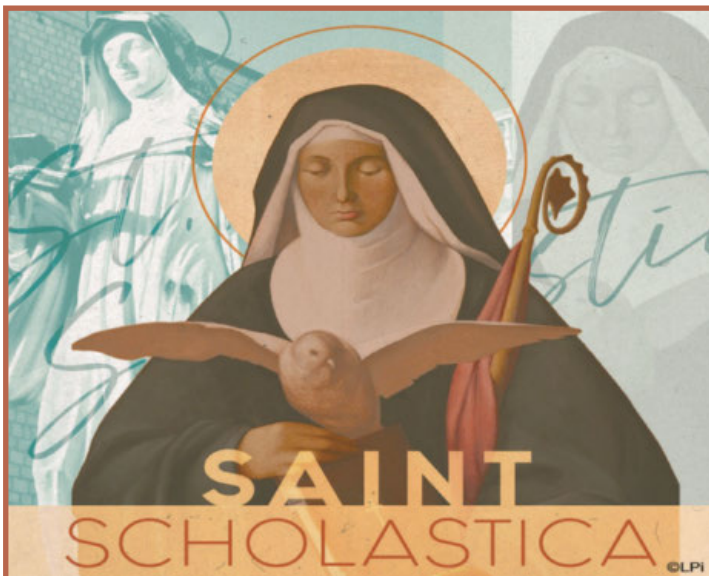

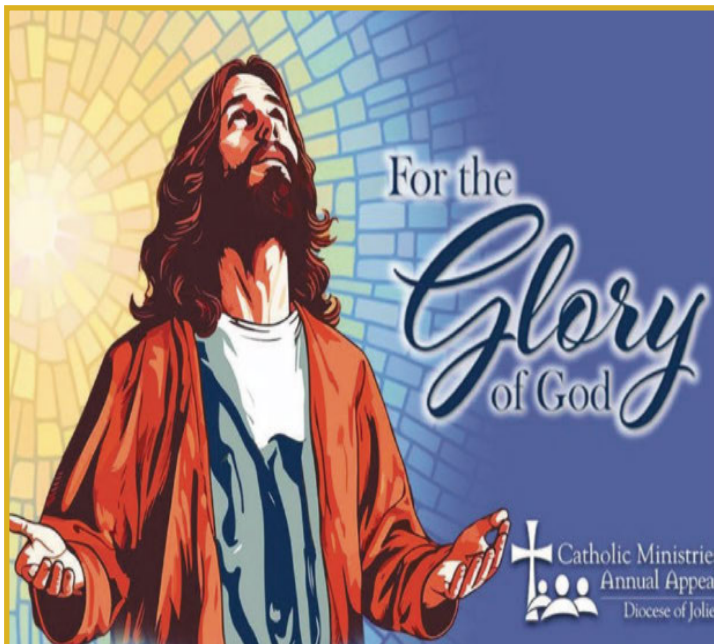
