

# 4<sup>TH</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER

"I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep." - Jn 10:14-15

Excerpts from the Lectionary for Mass ©2001, 1998, 1970 CCI

### Fr. Dan Hoehn — From the pastor's desk



The Fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally called "Good Shepherd Sunday", drawing upon the theme from the Gospel.

Much of Judea is a plateau with very inhospitable and rocky soil, more suited to grazing rather than to crops, and so Jesus' listeners would have been very familiar with sheep. Grass was scarce and so a

shepherd would have to continually move the flock from one spot to another. There were no fences or walls for protection, and because of this the shepherd always had to be with the flock.

In the Old Testament, God himself is presented as the shepherd of his people. "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want" (Psalm (23:1). "He is our God and we are his people, the flock he shepherds" (Psalm 95:7).

Isaiah describes the future Messiah with the image of the shepherd: "Like a shepherd he feeds his flock; in his arms he gathers the lambs, carrying them in his bosom, and leading the ewes with care" (Isaiah 40:11).

This ideal image of the shepherd finds its complete realization, of course, in Jesus Christ. He is the Good Shepherd who goes in search of the lost sheep; he feels compassion for the people because he sees them "as sheep without a shepherd" (Matthew 9:36); he calls his disciples "the little flock" (Luke 12:32). Peter calls Jesus "the shepherd of our souls" (1 Peter 2:25) and the Letter to the Hebrews speaks of him as "the great shepherd of the sheep" (Hebrews 13:20).

Today's Gospel passage highlights some of the characteristics of Jesus the Good Shepherd. The first has to do with the **reciprocal knowledge** that the sheep and shepherd have: "My sheep hear my voice and I know them and they follow me."

In certain areas of the world, sheep are raised mainly for their meat; but in Israel they were raised above all for wool and milk. For this reason they often remained for many years in the company of the shepherd who knew the character of each one and gave them affectionate names. What Jesus wants to say with these images is clear. He knows his disciples, he knows them "by name," which in biblical terms, means their innermost essence, the deepest truths about them.

Think about the deepest truths about yourself. Sometimes the deepest truths are the last things we would want to have published. We sometimes assume that the bad things are the deepest truths. We sometimes refer to the deepest truths as deep dark secrets.

But the one who knows those truths has laid down his life for you, in spite of those truths. So there must be some even *deeper* truth. Your sin is not what defines you.

The Good Shepherd loves each member of his flock with a personal love that treats each as if they were the only one who existed for him. Someone once said that Christ only knows how to count to one, and that one is each of us.

I find the image of a watchful and brave shepherd very comforting. We may not be threatened by wolves, but the temptation to sin is always lurking, and so the Good Shepherd is there standing watch, ready to come to our rescue in time of trial with all the graces necessary to resist the temptation. The Good Shepherd shows us what bravery looks like, and what love looks like.

As apt as the image of shepherd may be, it needed a qualifier – because everyone was familiar with bad shepherds, and hence the qualifier "good".

Interestingly, when God the Father wanted to convey his love through the Prophet Isaiah, he used the image of a mother – without the qualifier, and even as a rhetorical question: "Can a mother forget her infant, be without tenderness for the child of her womb? Even should she forget, I will never forget you." Mothers show us what love looks like, and what bravery looks like. Look at the Blessed Mother at the foot of the cross, who let her heart be pierced by a sword.

Whatever image God may use to convey to us the depth of his love, whether it is the Shepherd who calls us by name, who knows our innermost secrets and still loves us anyway, or the mother who could never forget her child, we can be confident that our understanding falls far short of the reality!





### Dear St. Michael Parish School Community:

The St. Michael School Board would like to express their hopes that each of our school families are finding this Easter season to be a time of renewal and reawakening of our faith. It is a journey that brings us back to Christ each year and reminds us of the sacrifices we make each day pale in comparison to the one Christ made for all of us on the cross.

Each spring the Board reaches out to the school community to prayerfully consider the opportunity to apply for a position on the School Board. This year there will be 3 positions open beginning next school year. Board members serve a three-year term, attend monthly meetings and serve on various committees.

The primary responsibilities of the Board are to support and advise the Pastor and Principal on policies and procedures related to the governance of the school. The Board monitors and helps to formulate the school budget and aids in recruitment efforts, which ensure the overall health of the school.

Each School Board Member shall reflect the following attributes:

- A genuine commitment to Catholic School education, its mission, and its future.
- A willingness and ability to make required time commitments to the work of the School Board.
- The ability to work with others effectively in reaching a consensus.
- A willingness to attend periodic in-service programs.
- A willingness to support school, parish, and Diocese of Joliet policy and to comply with all the requirements of any program mandated by the Diocese of Joliet for the protection of children and youth.
- A willingness and ability to maintain high levels of integrity and appropriate confidentiality
- A willingness and ability to be credible witnesses of the Catholic faith to the school, community, and parish.

The discernment process has traditionally been followed to fill vacancies on the Board. This process ensures the needs of the school and Board are appropriately met. The process consists of prayerful reflection by both the applicant and the current school board members in order to define the strength of each applicant and fill the needs of the Board. Following an interview with each candidate, follow-up discussion and reflection, a consensus will be reached.
