

TARGETED RESTRUCTURING TIMELINE

Since the announcement regarding Phase 3 of Targeted Restructuring (TR) three weeks ago, pastors of the affected parishes have met with Bishop Hicks and the TR Director of Implementation and have been apprised of the specifics of the process, including a timeline of events. The pastors also participated in a Pastoral Accompaniment Skills Training session, where they received very practical suggestions about accompanying one another and their parishioners throughout this process.

Each pastor has been asked to designate 3 – 6 parishioners and/or staff members to serve as Key Parish Leaders (KPLs) in the next portion of the targeted restructuring process. The KPLs will serve as the parish representatives as well as liaisons between their respective parishes and the Diocese. The pastors have been asked to identify the KPLs by the end of June.

The preliminary timeline of events from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025 is as follows:

July

 Pastoral Accompaniment Skills Training for KPLs on July 9 and July 24 (attendance at one session required, as the same content will be presented at both sessions)

September-October

- Two KPL meetings at the Blanchette Center to preview parish presentations
- · Two listening sessions open to all parishioners at each parish or group of parishes

November

- One or two KPL meetings at Blanchette Center
- KPLs provide written feedback on possible scenarios to the Diocese by the weekend before Thanksgiving December
 - Targeted Restructuring Committee (TRC) meets to analyze data and parish feedback, and discuss recommendations to Bishop Hicks
 - TRC provides written recommendations to Bishop Hicks the weekend before Christmas

2025

January - February

 Bishop Hicks discerns and makes his decisions, which will be publicly announced in parish bulletins February – March

 Pastors select members of Parish Transition Teams that will facilitate transitions to new parish realities March-June

Diocese works with Parish Transition Teams to implement changes effective July 1

July 1

· All changes go into effect

Again, it is important to stress that no decisions have been made about any of the parishes that will undergo a restructuring in Phase 3. The process will take several months and will involve input from many people. The Diocese will continue to communicate with the parishes on a regular basis and remains committed to transparency and support throughout this process.

May the Holy Spirit guide and comfort us as we accompany one another on this journey of discernment.



Dear Parish Family,

I'd like to take this opportunity to express my deepest gratitude for all of you, as I continue to celebrate the twentieth anniversary of my priestly ordination. (I intend to celebrate all year, incidentally!) The celebration

in the gym last Sunday was amazing — so many people, beautiful decorations, tons of food, open bar, and an ice cream truck in the parking lot! What more could anyone ask for? Your presence, beautiful cards and letters, well wishes, and support have meant the world to me.

Special thanks go out to all those who contributed to the gift of a new chalice! What a wonderful surprise! It is beautiful, with a lovely sentiment engraved on the bottom. My old chalice was one that had been gifted to the Catholic Extension Society in Chicago by the family of a priest who had died. (The Society offers the chalices free to seminarians before ordination.) The only thing I know about the deceased priest is his name, which is engraved on the bottom:

Morris P. Cahill. I have often prayed for him. (When I elevate the chalice slightly above the altar, I see his name on the bottom, reflected on the gold pattern just below!) Now I will daily see the St. Michael Parish Family written on the base of the chalice! (Not that I will need to be reminded, written, as you are, on my heart — to borrow a phrase from St. Paul [2 Cor. 3:2])!

I am truly grateful for your continued love and encouragement. This parish has been an amazing gift to me, and I thank God for having spent over half of my priesthood here with you. I'm praying for at least another twenty years, wherever I may be, God willing!

I didn't get to propose a toast last Sunday, so I will close by saying, "Here's to the good people of St. Michael Parish. May God continue to bless us with the joy of serving Him in faith and friendship."

Father's Day Second Collection


