



Fr. Dan Hoehn - from the pastor's desk



n this Father's Day weekend I would like to extend to all of the fathers in our parish a word of congratulations for having responded to this holy and lofty calling from God (the *Father*)!

I have often referred to an incident that, for me, was an eye-opener. About fifteen years ago I was instructing some young men in a juvenile detention center. The topic on one particular evening was *God the Father*. As I tried to make the point that God loves us as a Father, it became apparent to me that these young men were struggling with that concept. One of them asked, "You mean God *abuses* us?"

I found out that to him, a *father* was someone who came home drunk regularly and beat him. My attempt to explain that the essence of fatherhood was, in fact, a relationship of love meant nothing to him. As far as he was concerned, a father was an evil tyrant who inflicted arbitrary punishment. As I look back, it occurs to me that unconditional love is a very difficult concept to explain to someone who has never experienced it. I think it's kind of like trying to explain the difference between blue and green to someone who has been blind from birth. If you've never been able to see, then any talk about color is meaningless; you can't understand it unless you've experienced it.

Fortunately, this young man had experienced (to some extent) the love of a mother, and so I was able

to draw upon some of the Biblical images of maternal love; from Isaiah, ("Even if a mother could forget her child, I will never forget you") and Jesus's lament over Jerusalem, ("I yearned to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings."

What I distinctly remember that night is being impressed by the awesome responsibility that parents have toward their children. Here was a young man who may never understand the mercy or love or fidelity of God because his father did not reflect those qualities in any significant way.

The following is a reflection from the late Cardinal Mindszenty, whose survived imprisonment by Nazis during WWII:

The Importance of a Father

St. Joseph was strong in the face of adversity and poverty of his time. He is a model of the virtues of prudence, humility, strength and fortitude. Even though Joseph is "silent" in Scripture, his actions speak to us more clearly than recorded words. Just as Joseph resigned his own will to the will of God, so a good father walks the path as God sets it out for him. The greatest gift any father can give to his children is lifelong fidelity to his Marriage Covenant. Children learn about love through a father's affection, prayer, honor, self-control, forgiveness and integrity.






