I'M BACK, ST. MICHAEL CHURCH!

Who would have known that fourteen years after I cried my ugly goodbye cry back in 2010 that I would be back to be your pastor? I did not foresee that at all!

2007-2010 were three special years of my life. That time as the parochial vicar with (+) Fr. Don McLaughlin was full of joyful memories and positivity, encouragement and generosity. As a young priest then, I was still in a specific learning trajectory to becoming a pastor. I was also 145 pounds, in my mid-30's,

possibly in the best form that I had ever been, when the supply of energy never seemed to run out. When I left St. Michael, I felt the outpouring of love and gratitude from parishioners, the details are still very clear in my mind even today. At that time, three years seemed very short, and I was willing to stay for another three years, but the placement board saw that I had to move, to prepare me further to becoming a pastor. It came to pass, just one more year later, I would be pastor at St. Teresa in Kankakee, and some of you even came to my installation mass!

Now here's the in-between of the story. Since I left St. Mike's in 2010, I have served six other parishes, four of which were in Kankakee, where I was pastor for nine years. Before that, I finished my years as associate pastor by serving at St. Dominic Church in Bolingbrook. Post-Kankakee, I returned to DuPage as pastor of Mary Queen of Heaven in Elmhurst in the past four years. I believe that through the vicissitudes of priestly ministry in parishes, priests learn and grow, equipping them with the necessary graces to minister to the next community that they would serve. It is certainly true for me. Every parish assignment taught me some significant lessons about our earthly pilgrimage and the ongoing dialogue we have with God and our faith. I arrive here at St. Michael parish this weekend carrying with me all those learnings, aware that there is a reason why I am back here with you during this time of my personal narrative.

2024 has been an interesting and surprising year for me. I was not expecting to move to a new parish, after all I have only been at Mary Queen of Heaven for four years. On top of that, I am also working as director of ongoing formation for priests, which takes up a considerable amount of my time in parish ministry. It seemed to make sense to remain in a smaller parish. That's why when I received a call from the bishop on March 14, I gasped and held my breath when he told me that I was getting reassigned, and that I would be going to St. Michael in Wheaton. I immediately said yes, with all the good memories of the three years hyper-flashing in my mind. It was only when we were done with the phone call that things started to sink in, and I was taken over by sadness at the thought of leaving Elmhurst, wondering as to how I would manage the demands of a parish like St. Michael, and a sense of panic at the daunting task of moving again.

I took all of it to prayer, and I know that God wants me to simply trust Him as I have always done. I have been asked to do more demanding things than this, I had to remind myself. Surely, God equips his soldier for the battlefield. Notwithstanding, these feelings would remain until the day I said goodbye to the people of Mary Queen, and it still feels that way as I begin my first few days here with you. It has nothing to do with how I feel about St. Michael Parish. It has everything to do with my human condition. I am in process, I am grieving, I am excited to be here, I am grateful for this opportunity, I am overwhelmed by the details, and deep inside, I am scared at this responsibility. But there's only one thing to do: LET GOD SEE ME THROUGH THIS. And if I know what I have always known about you, St. Michael Parish, then, I am confident that our new time to be together will be very good, in Jesus' name.

I am back, St. Michael, hopefully a better version of the Fr. Sunny you knew fourteen years ago, but still the same priest who defines himself by the principles of joy, charity and gratitude. I look forward with grateful expectations of the great things that God has in store for all of us.

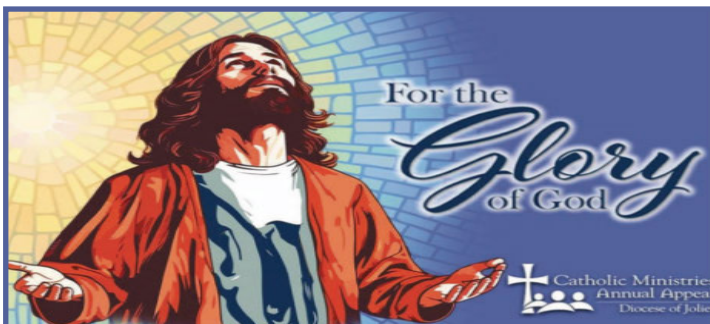

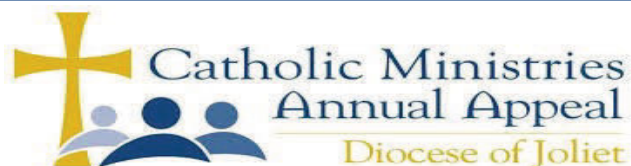
