#### THE GIFT OF THE EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS

Eighty-three years since the last one, the national Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis was one for our time, and I am so grateful that I invested some time to be part of it as much as I could.

A GREAT ENCOURAGEMENT. When I arrived in Indy on Wednesday, July 17, I saw the long lines of people queued to register at the Convention Center. I could feel the energy of excitement, and despite the heat and the obvious inconvenience of waiting, I saw everyone smiling and laughing a great time talking and meeting each other. As I walked past the crowds to the priest registration area, I felt grateful that there were no lines. People were smiling at me and greeting me, "Hello, Father!" like I met them before. I felt instantly at home. After registration, I went to the Eucharistic Adoration and saw a church full of people adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. There was an air of piety and solemnity that gave chills to my body. There were people of all ages and all diversities imaginable. The first day was highlighted by the gathering of everyone at Lucas Stadium where the opening mass was celebrated. There were reportedly over 50,000 people there, and everyone was excited to be part of this historical event. I gave me chills seeing the procession of the Eucharist! As the day ended, I recognized how edified I was by the experience. It was good to know that I am never alone in my Catholic faith. The Church is strong in its unity, and it was in full display at the Congress.

THE JOLIET CHURCH IN INDY. Bishop Ronald Hicks celebrated a Thursday afternoon mass at Saint Mary Catholic Church on New Jersey Street, not far from the venue with fifteen Joliet priests and a host of enthusiastic faithful from the Joliet Diocese. I was elated to be one of them. I saw parishioners from various parishes where I used to serve, and several Filipino contingents as well. Passing out worship aids and doing hospitality work by the door were our very own Colleen Broadhead and Janet Piszyk, who were both radiating joy and enthusiasm. It was so good to have time to be in this occasion, and it was the sacrifice of not being able to attend some very good presentations for that Thursday afternoon. I also missed a previous mass celebrated by Cardinal Luis Tagle and four Filipino bishops of the USA. In his homily, Bishop encouraged us all that in the midst of the overwhelming craziness of life, when we usually do not know if we are coming or going, the Eucharist is our constant guide and sure point of reference in everything that we do.

A BUFFET OF SPIRITUAL NOURISHMENT. I am sure everyone who went to the Eucharistic Congress, whether for a day, a few days, or for the entire event, have taken home various pieces of the whole Congress, and every experience was unique and personal. There were so many things that could be done and many experiences that could have been had, but at the end of the day, everyone had to make their own choices. I myself did not make it to the closing mass, because I returned to the parish for the weekend masses here. Whatever experiences I got, I know I was more than nourished to continue living my life for Jesus in the Eucharist, and to share my faith with others with greater boldness and confidence, knowing that there are many others who are doing it. I was also pleased to chance upon Kyle Langan, and Christine Kania, among others from around the diocese. I also received some messages from David and Stephanie Loiacono, telling me that they were there, but we never crossed paths. One thing is sure, I was nourished by the Eucharistic Congress. It is one of the best Catholic experiences I have ever had since I arrived in the USA in the year 2000.

As your pastor, it is my prayer that the positive experiences and the spiritual gifts that overflowed at the Congress can be shared somehow here at our parish. We will discern and follow the inspiration from the Holy Spirit. I am sure some graces will trickle down to everyone in our pews and homes. God bless our parish. May the Eucharistic Lord be enthroned in our hearts forever. Amen.






