

# Fr. Santos 'Sunny' Castillo — FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

## **SOME JOYFUL REDISCOVERIES**

It has been a month since I became your pastor, my dear St. Michael. It feels like a milestone, especially because many of you have been asking me how I am now, and if I have settled in nicely. I have also been offered many times in various ways any help that I need to get things situated and for me to have the smoothest possible transition into my new role here in our community. So, here's a word of thanks to all of you. I am feeling settled and I have felt like I have arrived, for sure. My feet have been wet enough this past month to know that I am in a new parish as a new pastor, and things have to really move forward.

Let me tell you some ten things that I have joyfully discovered and rediscovered about our parish:

Our church, the actual worship space and environment, IS so beautiful and conducive to worship. Thanks to the Building Committee of 2001 onwards who worked with Fr. Don McLaughlin for the legacy of an excellent church where the Church can pray and worship together, and build community as a spiritual family.

- I love having the tabernacle in the center of the sanctuary. Fr. Dan brought that transition during his early years as the pastor. Something about having Jesus, our Eucharistic Lord, in the middle of the sanctuary speaks who is enthroned as King in our church.
- I really love the energy of people going to church. You have brought me so much joy watching you all go to church with everybody in the family. Whether you come alone, or with company, you matter and the Lord wants you to grow in faith, hope and love with the rest of us. But something looks so encouraging when I see young families going to church with the children.
- I am proud to see that our people stay! I mean, I have been to parishes where people seem to rush out of church, they are out of the space before the priest even leaves, or in other more disturbing cases, people leave after they receive communion and no longer wait for the final prayers, blessings and sending forth. Not here at Saint Michael! People stay, you stay and you fill the narrhex with so much energy and conversation after the mass, I am edified by the sense of welcome and community that it fosters.
- I am so happy to see the Burmese families coming to church! I remember starting the ministry to welcome refugees in our parish all the way back to 2008, when I met the first Burmese families that arrived in Wheaton. I remember organizing them and shortly after inviting our parishioners to organize ourselves to provide a ministry to help them settle in our community. - I used to struggle a lot with doing the 6:30 AM masses, because I am not really a morning person. In fact, I have to admit that it was one of my immediate concerns when I found out that I was coming back. How would my older self be able to handle an early mass like that? Well, guess what... not so bad at all! The Lord seems to have given me the grace to not struggle as much as I used to. It must be part of aging to wake up earlier and require less sleep. The growing days are over, I suppose.
- On Tuesday, August 6, I will remember Fr. Don McLaughlin in a special way. A year ago, I was with Maribeth and Philip Spittler in the hospice center at the moment of his passing, and I still can't believe that he has gone to rest. There is still a lot of things in our parish that carry some incredibly beautiful memories of being with him. Even using the office where he worked as pastor makes me feel so connected with him, remembering the many mornings I would catch him returning emails in the very early hours of the day.
- It will take a while, an entire pastorate assignment to unveil the many facets of our parish. That is because God works that way. It is impossible to keep up with the details of God's inner working in our lives. I don't think we need to know all of it. We just need to know enough to realize that He is working within the life of our church. That's a blessed assurance!
- It got harder to remember people's names. I am also very much involved in getting to know people and learn or relearn people's names. I hope that you don't get tired introducing yourselves by name; it has been very helpful. Even from 14 years ago, when it seemed very easy to remember names, this now 51 year-old pastor is struggling with retaining names of people, even though I can recognize faces very well.
- We are a parish that prays well and works well. Needless to say, these are ongoing days of discovering details about our parish, how things are done, how ministries are structured, how masses and liturgies as well as sacraments are prepared, executed and followed up.

I am proud to be with you, my dear Saint Michael family, to grow in love with God together. I am really enjoying these rediscoveries, like re-opening a gift that was given long ago, and is still as beautiful and valuable as the day I received it. God bless our parish!


