

#### Fr. Santos 'Sunny' Castillo - From the pastor's desk

#### ARE YOU AN AMBASSADOR?

Last weekend, in my homilies, I not only spoke about the sad trend of decline of mass attendance in the country, and provided some of the prevailing reasons why such trend is plaguing the churches, especially the Catholic Church, in our time. I also recognized the fact that despite this trend, you, our dear parishioners, are still in church, and we have an abundance of faithful families who come to celebrate together every weekend. I choose to see it as an opportunity, a call to action if you may, for heroes and ambassadors to rise to this occasion. Like I said, I desire as your pastor that our parish will be the anomaly to the trend. That instead of seeing a 50% decline in attendance, we will see a 100% increase in attendance in our liturgies.

Yes, we need ambassadors who will speak, witness, invite and nurture on behalf of Jesus Christ and His Church, our Church. Let's imagine this together. If every person brings in another person to the community this year. That would double our number. And if we do this again for another year, that will triple our number in just two years. That is the multiplying power of divine ambassadorship. Read what Saint Paul says in 2 Corinthians 5: 17-21:

"So, whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come. And all this is from God, who has reconciled us to himself through Christ and given us the ministry of reconciliation, namely, God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting their trespasses against them and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. So, we are ambassadors for Christ, as if God were appealing through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who did not know sin, so that we might become the righteousness of God in him."

When we reflect on what God is asking of us, these words from Saint Paul seem to provide enlightenment. As ambassadors of Christ, He is asking us to a ministry of reconciliation by becoming the righteousness of God in Jesus Christ, for the renewal of creation. Wow. It cannot be any clearer than that.

**RECONCILIATION**. To forgive one another. To reconcile. To make peace with each other. To admit our faults and failings, but also to seek mercy from each other. To be healed from our wounds. We all sin, we all have blinders, we all have limits and shortcomings. We are all broken. We all need God. Why do we have to break each other when we can help each other to be whole?

**RIGHTEOUSNESS**. God is holy and righteous. But we can live righteous lives through Him. It is an inward movement within ourselves, which we accomplish in prayer and devotion. It is NOT about positioning ourselves as judge of others, but rather, to be companions of people to Jesus the healer. Our righteousness is best expressed in our compassion for others, to help them find Jesus despite ourselves. True righteousness is living our lives as instruments for others to discover Christ in us, not because we did it on our own, but because God's grace abounds in us.

**NEW CREATION**. This is the vision of the Kingdom of God, a new heaven and a new earth. It is not just a future event. It is happening and can happen here and now. A happy, holy and healthy family going to church together is a vision of heaven. Friends loving each other is a vision of heaven. Jesus is doing the work of renewing NOW into the fullness of the Kingdom.

This is a vision. I feel so inspired right now to even write about it for sharing purposes. Like I said last week, I am looking for ambassadors for Jesus and His Church, and when I say Church, I mean, all of us in flesh and blood, in the divine family of the faith. As you read this article this weekend, please know that this is an ongoing invitation. As your pastor, I need you to be an ambassador. When you are ready to respond, please talk to me.

God bless our parish family. God bless the Church. God bless all who seek Him with sincerity of heart.






