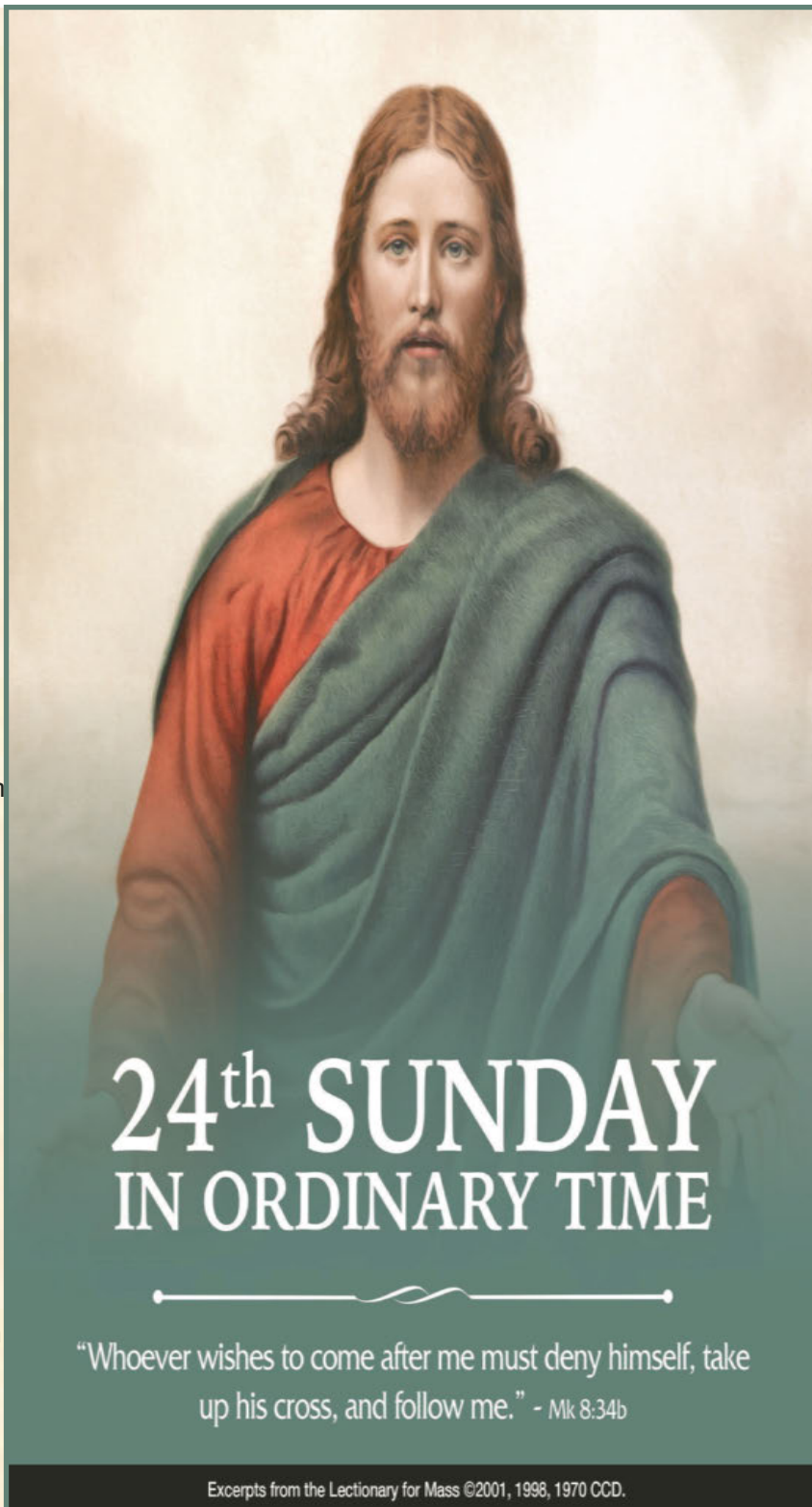

SOME AWESOME THINGS GOING ON...

I love being the bearer of Good News! I can imagine how excited the apostles were to tell the rest of the disciples that Jesus rose from the dead and that they actually saw Him. I imagine the two that walked with him to Emmaus, and how excited they were to go back to the disciples to let them know that they saw Him and recognized Him at the breaking of the bread. As your pastor, I am sure the good news that I share is not exactly to those levels, but I am excited to share them, nonetheless.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION BEGINS. This week, our religious education program starts and we are very excited to have our children go through their formation and grow more in their life of faith and devotion. Thank you to the Religious Education Team and volunteers under the leadership of Mrs. Colleen Brodhead, we are very prepared to tackle the demands of our program. I am aware of the investment of time and energy that has been put to prepare for this new school year, so children and families, please be excited!

ALTAR SERVER TRAINING IS ON. I have sent out a video invitation to our children and their parents and families to invite them to join the ranks of our amazing altar servers. Training sessions are scheduled for September 21 (after the 5 PM mass), September 25 (at 2:30 PM) and September 26 (at 4:30 PM). Our hope is to build this ministry and include some sessions of formation and fellowship. Thank you to our families who have already inquired about participating. As a former altar server myself, I know the great opportunity that it offers for being so close and personal with the mystery of the Eucharistic celebration, and how it helps mold my personal discipline, character, devotion and faith.

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS GOES FULL GEAR. We were able to create a new syllabus for this year's OCIA, and I am pumped to be hands on in the journey of those who are in the program this year! We had our first session, an introductory one, last week, and this week, we will have our first official presentation from the syllabus. The number of participants is still growing, because just last weekend, I was introduced to two young adult men who are going to be joining the journey as well. With the Holy Spirit's guidance, I know this will be a very fruitful year. I encourage even our seasoned Catholics to join our sessions, especially those who feel the need to do a Catholic review. Each of us have so much more to learn about our faith, and the OCIA is a great way to discover and rediscover the richness of the Catholic faith.

OUTREACH MINISTRIES GET MORE VISION. I sat down with Bob Janssen on Tuesday morning to review our Outreach efforts in our parish. Saint Michael proves to be a generous community, exactly how I remembered it from fifteen years ago. Many of our parishioners have been supporting our outreach efforts, and we have been focused on supporting our local outreach initiatives around the Wheaton area. We are dreaming to look beyond our local community again, just like in those years when we supported worthy charitable institutions in Nigeria (Dominican School in Lagos) and Thailand (Sarnelli AIDS Orphanage for Children in Nong Khai, Thailand). We hope to provide more opportunities to respond to global needs in the future, and to provide more information about our ongoing efforts. I believe that our parishioners will find a lot of encouragement to know the outreach platforms that we have been supporting over the years.

UPCOMING MINISTRY FAIR LOOKS AHEAD WITH HOPE. Toward the end of the month, in time for our parish feast day weekend on September 29, we will have a Ministry Fair and Sign-up Weekend. I hope you are excited to find many opportunities to serve others and participate in the life of our parish. Everyone is encouraged to use their gifts for the service of God and neighbor. In the same spirit, I am ever thankful to our many volunteers that make Saint Michael the vibrant parish that it is. I am very hopeful about your response to active participation, so here's an advance thank you!

When the Spirit of God is at work within us, we produce great and lasting fruits. I pray that these ongoing efforts of our parish will indeed produce short and long-term benefits for the wellbeing of the people who call our parish their spiritual home. God bless our ministries, God bless our families, God bless our parish. Amen.

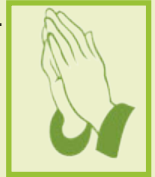

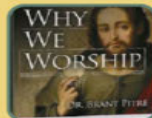
