LOOKING FORWARD WITH GREAT JOY

I learned very early in my ministry as a priest that if I do not calendar my time away early in the fiscal year, there is a great likelihood that I will not be able to maximize all the days that are allotted for a priest to use for vacations, retreat and ongoing formation. And so all these years, I have been very systematic and mathematical about those days, and I always look forward to them, especially with the action-packed life we live in ministry here at Saint Michael.

Unlike Father Jacob who has taken all six weeks of his allotted time away in his one trip back to Nigeria, I have broken my vacation, retreat and continuing education schedule into three major trips this year. (Btw, for those who were asking, Fr. Jacob has not moved out; he is just gone for six weeks back to his home country, and will be returning before the end of this month.) The first of the three trips is happening by the first week of October.

MARIAN PILGRIMAGE. I am looking forward to my pilgrimage to the Marian Shrines of Portugal, Spain and France, which includes a visit to the incredible apparition sites of Our Lady of Fatima, Our Lady of Lourdes and Our Lady of the Pillar (Zaragoza), as well as the epic places of Marian devotion like the Almudena in Madrid, the Black Madonna of Montserrat and Our Lady of La Mercè in Barcelona. On top of all that, my pilgrim group will also visit a prominent site of a Eucharistic Miracle in Santarem, Portugal, and the cities associated to some saints like Lisbon, Avila, Toledo, Coimbra and Salamanca. I am sharing my excitement to go back for my sixth time in this region because of all my many pilgrimages, this has proven to produce the most reported answered prayers. Something about the devotion to our Heavenly Mother must surely open passage ways of graces and blessings in this trip. So, I invite you to share your intercessions and prayer requests with me before I leave. You are welcome to write the intentions down and drop them at a basket provided by the baptismal font. You are also able to email the prayer request to the parish office.

THE INTERNATIONAL PILGRIM STATUE OF FATIMA. In the same spirit, I am excited to announce that the International Pilgrim Status of Our Lady of Fatima will visit Saint Michael Parish for the first time on October 16, 2024! As the current spiritual director of the World Apostolate of Fatima (Blue Army) Joliet Chapter, I am privileged to bring this gift to our parish. This statue is very special! Here are some important things to know about the statue:

"The beautiful image of Our Lady of Fatima was designed by famous sculptor José Thedim in 1947. Sister Lucia herself instructed him, and later remarked that she had never seen any image which so resembled the actual apparition of Our Lady. The bishop of Fatima entrusted the image to John Haffert, co-founder of the Blue Army, and prayed that Mary herself accompany the statue wherever it goes. It has traveled around the globe many times for more than 76 years and continues its journeys today under the custody of the World Apostolate of Fatima, USA – Our Lady's Blue Army. An uninterrupted flow of graces and favors have been reported wherever the statue has traveled, including physical cures (which can only be officially pronounced by Church authorities), favors granted and numerous conversions. The purpose of the Pilgrim Virgin Statue tours was and still is to bring the graces of Fatima and Our Lady's message of hope, peace and salvation to those many millions of people who may never have an opportunity to make a pilgrimage to Fatima itself."

I look forward with great joy for these incredible opportunities to grow in our devotion, in our love of the Virgin Mary, which leads to our love of her Son Jesus. As always, you are in my heart and thoughts in my prayers, my dear Saint Michael family. God bless our parish!

Diocese of Joliet 75th Anniversary Regional Mass




All are invited to join us in celebration of the Diocese of Joliet 75th Anniversary! Please join us!
