### VOCATION AWARENESS WEEK: Discerning What God Has Planned For You

Back at a dance club in Manila in 1998, when I was still working for television, I heard these words deep within my soul" "What are you doing, why are you here?" That powerful inner voice helped me to rediscover the true purpose of my life. It called my attention to think about why I am in this world in the first place, and then it challenged me to align the things that I do with the reason for my being. That inner voice that I heard in the dance club was the pivotal moment that brought me to my vocation as a priest.

Faith tells us that we are all wonderfully, beautifully made, and our lives are meaningful because God already had a plan for us the moment we came to life in our mother's womb! (Please pause and reflect again on that idea and allow it to just sink in your heart and mind.) Yes, God's purposefulness and wisdom is such that His creative love is always purposeful. The immediate implication of this is that while there are many pathways to living a joyful, holy and meaningful life, pathways that we can all so choose to tread by our own desire, it is good to first ask the question, "What did God have in mind when I was conceived in my mother's womb?" Whatever God had in His Divine Mind then, we think of that as our personal calling, our reason for being, our vocation.

A UNIVERSAL VOCATION TO HOLINESS. By our baptism, we received the divine calling to become a saint. The Catechism # 2013 teaches us: "All Christians in any state or walk of life are called to the fullness of Christian life and to the perfection of charity." All are called to holiness: "Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." (Matthew 5: 48). This universal vocation is the foundation of every other kind of vocation. It connects every vocation to the shared grace that is received by every Christian on the day of their baptism. It also grounds every vocation to the Paschal Mystery, the salvific work of Christ on the cross. Simply put, every baptized Christian has a vocation to be made holy in Jesus Christ.

NATIONAL VOCATION AWARENESS WEEK. The week of November 3-9, 2024 is the annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promoting vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations. And so, we enjoin our efforts as a parish to invite our friends and family to discern the call of God to the vocation of service in the Church as a priest, deacon or consecrated religious. Over the years, Saint Michael has born fruits in these vocations. In our prayer garden, we can find parishioners who have been ordained priests and deacons or consecrated into religious orders or perpetual virginity. This is our ongoing task to bring such consciousness to our children and young.

SOWING SEEDS OF VOCATION IN OUR CHILDREN. The idea of living the life of a priest, deacon or consecrated religious may be easily daunting to any Catholic person, but sowing seeds of vocation does not have to be complicated. It starts with introducing our children to God, talking to them about how God works in their lives and in the family, and modeling for them a life of prayer, where they can have an intimate conversation with God. Develop in them a spirit of gratitude, which is the very heart of what we do at every holy mass. Demonstrate to them how to translate gratitude into service and charity. When we do these, we provide an environment where they can fall in love with God. Then God does the rest. This is the simple foundation of holiness, which will never be wasted in their life. And if the Lord does call them to serve in the priesthood, deaconate and religious life, then we will all celebrate what God will have done.

May the Lord bless all those who seek His Will with a sincere heart. Amen.





# The impact of formation into priesthood



When someone asks me what the seminary is, I liken it to a garden bed which takes the seeds of a vocation to the priesthood, plants them in rich and nutritious soil, provides them with the necessary sun, moisture, and darkness so that the seed can grow and bear much fruit. It provides a space to remove the weeds of human weakness and protect the vocation from the buffets of the storms and winds that come with life.

I see this in my own experience of formation. When I began seminary after my four years at the University of Illinois, where I studied chemical engineering, I thought I had my life together and knew a thing or two. What I discovered living with 150 other men was that I was embarking upon a journey to grow in honesty with myself, my heart, and God. One day on retreat, I was telling God I wanted to be a great priest, and He responded, 'then you must know what people are feeling and experiencing.' I told him I did, and He gently corrected me and said, 'to do that, you must know what you are feeling and

experiencing.

I didn't know that I had closed off my heart to love of my neighbor due to all the bullying I encountered in grade school. I was usually angry, but wouldn't let anvone



In seminary, a space was created to assist me in being honest with myself, my heart and God about the pain and betrayals of life. It gave me a space to avail myself to counseling, spiritual direction and good friendships which helped me grow, heal, and forgive. The beautiful fruit of this time was that I grew in a genuine love for my brother and all who I would be called to serve in the Church as a priest.

It was through the generosity of the Diocese of Joliet faithful that I was able to attend seminary. I invite you to prayerfully ask the Holy Spirit, how he might be inviting you to support our current seminarians in their formation to the priesthood.

God Bless you and be assured of my prayers for you.

ABOUT FR. BORELLO

Fr. Steven Borello is a priest of the Diocese of Joliet currently serving as the Director of Vocations.

Fr. Steven grew up in Glen Ellyn, Illinois, and is the oldest of 4 children.

He attended the University of Illinois in Champaign-Urbana where he studied chemistry and chemical engineering.

While there, he received a call to the seminary to discern the priesthood.

He received his Bachelors in Theology and Masters of Divinity from Mundelein Seminary and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Joliet in 2011.

He first served as an associate pastor at Notre Dame Parish in Clarendon Hills and was then transferred to Saints Peter and Paul Parish in Naperville in June of 2014.

In August of 2015, he began serving at St. John Vianney College Seminary as a spiritual director, director of human formation, and instructor to over 120 men discerning a priestly vocation.

He returned to the Diocese of Joliet in August 2018 to begin as the Director of Vocations.


