# Fr. Santos 'Sunny' Castillo - From the pastor's desk

# WAIT... THE TIME IS NOW! A NEW ADVENT BEGINS...

Welcome to the Advent Season, my dear parishioners!

It is the season of waiting, a special time that reminds us of the polarity of where we are in the history of salvation, because we begin a new liturgical journey in the Church. But we also ironically do it by preparing for the Coming of the Lord at the end of time, which is the theme of the first two weeks of Advent. Either way, there is a prevailing Christian disposition that we all share together, that is, WE ARE PEOPLE IN WAITING. We are waiting for Jesus!

Here is a question that might help us focus at what is important during this season: If Jesus is coming tomorrow, how are you going to spend the last day and quickly prepare for His glorious arrival?

**PRAYERS OF PREPARATION.** My immediate thought for this question is to pray. To silence myself within and enter into an intimate dialogue with Him. I will tell Him to help me be ready, to help me prepare, to dispose me for His arrival, because I desire for Him to be pleased with what He finds at His coming.

**HEALING AND RECONCILIATION.** At the heart of my preparation, I will spend some time to reconcile myself with everything and everyone. I will seek healing and forgiveness. I will offer reconciliation and mercy with those around me, and offer my peace to my loved ones. I will also receive the sacrament of reconciliation, so that I am spiritually prepared to receive and welcome the Lord.

ACTS OF CHARITY. I will spend the final day being intentional about doing good to others around me. Remembering the wisdom of St. John of the Cross, it is only by how much we have loved that we will all be judged by the Lord at the end of time. Final moments of kindness and random acts of generosity are good ways to dispose myself for the coming of the Lord.

**BE WITH MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS.** For the final day, I would love to be able to spend it with family and friends. I will gather them all together so that we can all meet the Lord together. I imagine how wonderful it would be if we all woke up to the New Heaven and New Earth together and share the fullness of God's glory as one with all the angels and saints.

How about you, my dear parishioners? Don't you have the feeling that the final day would be too late for some of the things that I have mentioned above?

This first Sunday of Advent, the holy summon of God is found in the words of the Gospel this weekend: "... stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand." In other words, we do not wait for the final day or the final hour. Be prepared NOW. Saint Paul gives us this same teaching when he wrote: "For he (the Lord) says: 'In an acceptable time: I heard you, and on the day of salvation I helped you (Isaiah 49:8a).' Behold, now is a very acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation. Now, this Advent Season is the time to pray the prayers of preparation, it is the time for healing and reconciliation, the time for charity, the time to be with family and friends to share the love and peace that will usher us all together into the Kingdom of God, the day of Jesus Christ.

It is in this Spirit that I urge you to make good use of this season to focus on what truly matters. The next two weeks will guide us to reflect on the coming of Jesus at the end of time, and then the final two weeks of Advent will prepare us for the coming of the great Solemnity of Christmas. In all these four weeks of the Advent Season, we are preparing for the coming of the day of Jesus. Know of my intensified prayers for our parish community, for the entire Church to observe reverently and beautifully this season of grace. God bless those who wait on His mercy!
