## SOME DREAMS AND VISIONS FOR 2025

The beginning of the year is always a great time to reboot and start well. As I have been your pastor since July 2024, I have been prayerfully discerning certain aspects of our parish that I hope to take to a specific direction. There are also a lot of things that are happening in our parish that are hopeful in building up the condition of our parish in general. As we begin this new year, I wish to share with you some of these thoughts, with the invitation to help me pray and discern them well. I want to begin realizing these things with a clarity of purpose and with a blessed reminder that these are fruits of my own prayerful thoughts and discernment, but it has somehow to be supported by the strength of the community's devotion, tenacity and resolve. For what's it worth, please consider these as your pastor's dreams for our parish:

**WILLOW STREET PROJECT.** This is something that has been started before I arrived here, and I am in full support of the initiatives that have been undertaken so far. There are expected changes in our parish neighborhood, most significantly, a condominium building that is expected to rise in the block south of the tracks, between Wheaton and Hale Streets. That will have a big effect in our area, and we need to ensure safety in our campus. With all the crossing of children and adults between our main building and the Faith Center, the portion of Willow Street that cuts through our whole campus is going to be even more dangerous than it already is today. The Buildings and Grounds Committee, the parish Finance Council and the Parish Staff are all in the same heart and mind about approaching our city with a plan to close that short block to help keep our campus more safe and unified. This weekend, we actually share the details of this plan to our parish community. See Pages 4 & 5 for more information. Prayers and support are needed!

**PARISH COUNCIL.** This month, I am taking concrete steps to reinstating a fully functioning and dedicated Parish Council. I do not know exactly when Saint Michael Parish Council became defunct; nonetheless, I recognize the importance of having one. Please pray that the Lord will send the people to this forum, ones with great concern for our parish, a sense of community, and a high level of prudence and vision to be able to work closely with me in this conciliar platform.

**STAFF TEAM BUILDING.** The parish staff is a very important service team in our parish. They are my direct collaborators. As a pastor, I am not exempt from errors, blinders and forgetfulness. I know that I have already made some boo-boo's with my staff since I arrived here, but I want to seriously bring the staff to work more cohesively and understand each other more. I also wish that they can understand me better in terms of my own expectations, priorities, and visions. Thanks to their love of our parish, they have remained faithful, supportive and optimistic, through all the many things that happen in our parish lives.

**YOUTH RE-IMAGINED.** One of my very first considerations about our parish since I arrived is our need to amplify the voice of our youth, by providing them with an environment where they can have the support and encouragement that they need during this time of their lives. On January 12, we hope to provide our teens a powerful experience of community and prayer, praise and worship and organization, so that they can have an open forum on how our parish can help them build a network of encouragement in their faith and human story. The invite stands, and the invitations are everywhere. I ask the parish parents to please consider this initiative.

**EVANGELIZATION TEAM.** I have started a discussion about my vision to focus our parish efforts on evangelization with the Adult Faith Formation team when I was starting as your pastor, and I have not forgotten the promise that I will provide direction for our parish teams and interest groups that are doing this task to impart more information and strategic action plans on spreading the faith and inviting people to a deeper spirituality and commitment to growing in the faith.

**FORMATION FORUM FOR LITURGICAL MINISTRIES.** We have a very robust team of ministers here at Saint Michael. I know that everyone is dedicated and mean well to bring their own gifts and talents to the liturgy of the church. But I have found that there is an urgent need to engage our liturgical ministry teams in going back to basic dispositions of service and refocus on the spirituality of the ministry of the altar. This is something that I have done in all my parishes in the past and has proven to help in avoiding stresses in liturgical services.

**SCHEDULE AND STRUCTURES OF LITURGIES AND FORMATION PROGRAMS.** I know that there have been some adjustments and changes that were made during the COVID years, in response to immediate situations brought by the pandemic. Now, as we have these protocols behind us, we can look again at the basic timing and structures of our liturgies and formation programs.

**COMMUNITY BUILDING STRATEGIES.** As there are developments and changes happening at St. Mark Parish by the end of this fiscal year, we need to be aware of the need for continuing a positive culture of integration, hospitality and community building. As new people enter the portals of our parish family, we are called to be intentional in providing opportunities of contact and encounter among our parishioners and the larger community.

These are some of the bigger picture dreams and visions, and then there are those that are equally important in the particular aspects of the life of our parish.

Daily school bus activity will occur on campus, alleviating conflicts associated with the temporary closure of Wheaton Avenue

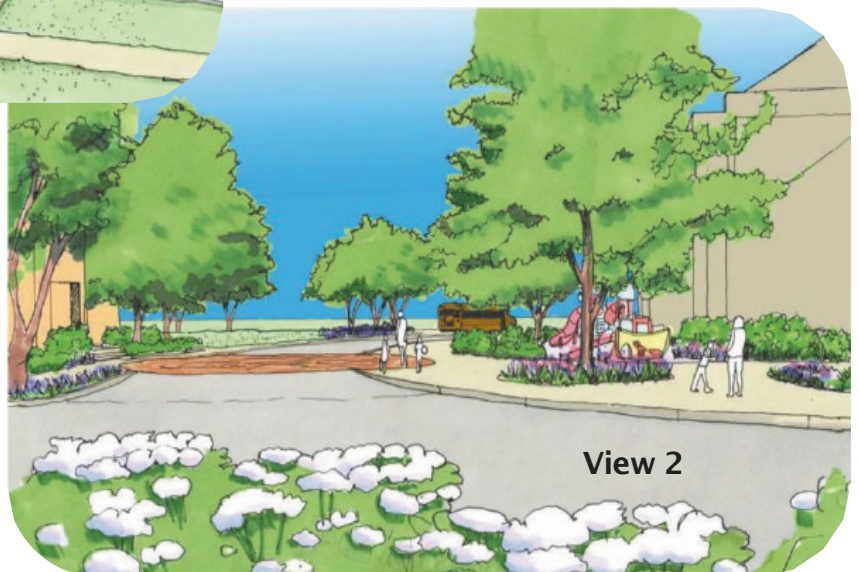
A unified campus improves the utilization of green gathering spaces / provides us with an additional 41 parking spaces

View 1: Looking West at Willow Avenue and South Wheaton Avenue - St. Michael Parish School (l) and Faith Center (r)



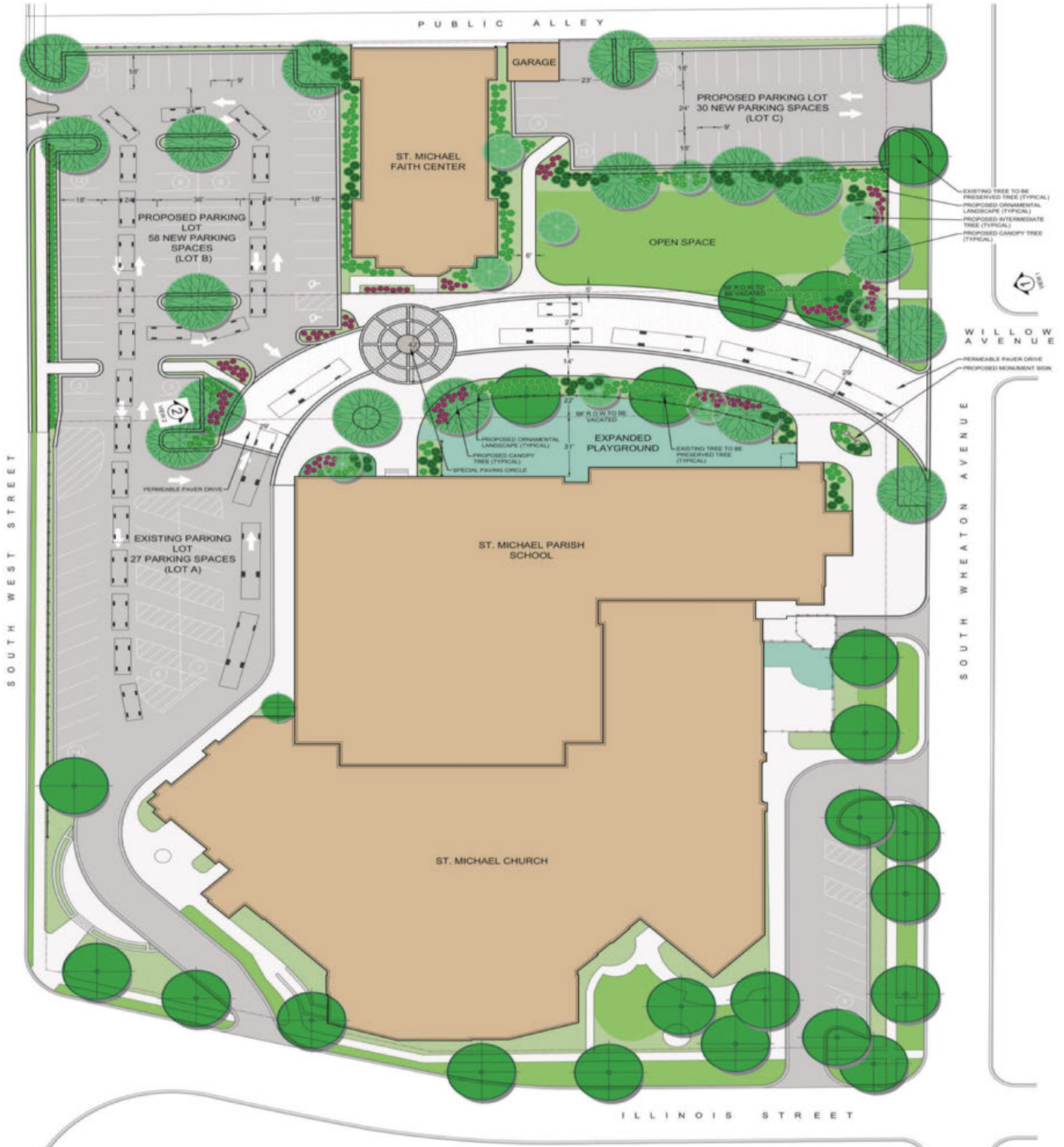
