# THE LEGACY OF CATHOLIC EDUCATION

As we celebrate this year's Catholic Schools Week, it is conversations regarding Catholic Schools in the Diocese good to remind ourselves about the value of Catholic of Joliet, there is a consistent and repeated mention of Education.

In the 19th century, when Catholic immigrants from Ireland first arrived in the Newfound Land, they were mostly concentrated in Maryland. While there was a Protestant sentiment that children of Irish immigrants should be educated in public schools to become American, the Catholics instead built parochial schools to protect the faith of their children. During those early years of Catholic immigration, the parish schoolteachers were nuns that belonged to religious communities. Catholic schools were seen as the first and most important means to teach the faith to the next generation. It was an indispensable ministry of evangelization for every Catholic parish of the time.

THE REALITY OF CATHOLIC EDUCATION TODAY. In our diocese, we have recently seen the closing of a number of Catholic schools. In the past five years, we may have heard of the closing of Holy Family School (Bensenville), Saint Dominic School (Bolingbrook) and Sacred Heart School (Lombard), Saint Paul the Apostle School (Joliet), Saint Jude School (Joliet) and Saint Matthew School (Glendale Heights). We are also seeing a trend of decline in enrollment to Catholic Schools throughout the diocese. Statistics also show that only 30% (or even less) of Catholic School students regularly attend Sunday mass, casting doubts to many church leaders whether parochial schools still accomplish the same reason why Catholics schools were originally established. People question whether the Catholic Identity of parochial schools and other catholic institutions of higher education, has diminished drastically to the point that they have become more of private schools. Many see these as telltale signs of the future of Catholic Education not only in our diocese but throughout the country.

In the face of these realities in our current state of affairs as a diocese, and as Catholics in America, WHAT HOPEFUL RESPONSE CAN WE OFFER TO ARGUE THAT CATHOLIC SCHOOLS ARE STILL RELEVANT AND EFFECTIVE VENUES FOR MOLDING THE FAITH OF OUR CHILDREN AND EVANGELIZING A YOUNG POPULATION THAT NEEDS TO HEAR THE BEAUTIFUL AND PROPHETIC VOICE OF THE CHURCH TODAY? There was a time when I did not have much to offer to the conversation, because I too was feeling a sense of desperation about the fate of Catholic Education in our diocese and in this country. But not anymore. Now, I have a response.

SAINT MICHAEL PARISH SCHOOL IS A BEACON OF HOPE FOR CATHOLIC EDUCATION. My response is, "Look at Saint Michael School!" Since arriving here as pastor in July 2024, I have seen the reason why in many

conversations regarding Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Joliet, there is a consistent and repeated mention of Saint Michael School. Our very own parish school is being seen in our diocese as a true exemplary icon of a thriving, effective and healthy Catholic School. Here are some reasons why:

Parishioners Support. Many parishioners support our Catholic School, not only financially but also morally. It is obvious that our parishioners identify with the goals and visions of our school.

Excellent Administration. Principal Adam Ferguson, together with Ms. Lisa Los and the rest of the team of the school administration and school board are fully invested in the life of the parish. They are outstanding ambassadors of the school and the parish at large. They are therefore excellent liaisons between the school and the rest of the church.

Committed Parents. The Parent Board is equally passionate in ensuring that the school is thriving and well supported. They represent the entire population of parents who are looking not only out for the welfare of their individual children but are looking to the school and the parish as their community, or even more importantly, their spiritual family.

Dedicated Teachers. Our teachers are our heroes. I see their dedication, commitment and true concern for their students. As a collective force of positive influence for our students, they really provide the meat and backbone of our parish school.

JUST REALLY GOOD KIDS. I have been in various collaborations and interactions with students of various schools in our diocese, and I have to say that our children here at Saint Michael School are just really good. It is not to say that our prefect of discipline is just doodling his fingers, but there is much to say about the true goodness and docile openness of our students. I always enjoy watching them line up to church on Wednesdays, and their discipline and participation at mass is outstanding.

Truly, our parish school makes me believe in the importance of Catholic Education. I pray that in the many years to come, Saint Michael School can continue to advance in being a seedbed for fruitful lives, to provide a solid foundation of life for our children to grow into excellent Catholics and outstanding citizens for the world. 




Our parish's goal for the 2025 CMAA is \$177,100 and 70% of any amount we raise over our goal will be returned to us and used fruitfully within our own parish.


