

I do hope that we live up to the promise that it will be an enlightening and engaging time, especially because I have been praying for and thinking about it for some time now. However and whenever we achieve these goals, I would like you, my dear parishioners, to know that I am very committed to making sure that our ministry teams are growing and are getting some experience of formation, spirituality, communication, and reaffirmation. Formation is needed because time and again, we have to be reminded about the ideals that we are trying to uphold in our ministry and service. It is a privilege and also a responsibility. Ministry is an opportunity for learning more about the faith, and learning more about how God works. **Spirituality** is needed because if we are just doing what we do out of our love of humanity, or to fulfill our own personal needs, or to push a certain agenda, then the value of what we are doing will not have long-lasting effects and it will not be relevant to our own journey to eternal life. Ministry is an opportunity to walk with Jesus and His Church to everlasting life, guided by the Spirit. Therefore, we need to always refocus with the spiritual lens of our ministry. Communication is needed because we always have to see every ministry in the light of the bigger picture of our parish mission. No one is supposed to work as an autonomous entity in church ministry. Ministry fosters the harmony of the Body of Christ, where all are collaborating and sharing, while being heard and consulted at the same time. It is also a time to communicate with you some of the ongoing dreams and concerns of the parish community from my point of view as your pastor. By communication, I hope to enhance collaboration, empowering our ministry teams and volunteers to become better ambassadors for our parish. And finally, reaffirmation is needed because our volunteers need to hear the good that is going on, the good that they are doing, the gratitude that we are feeling for all of their efforts, and the pride that our parish has for all the accomplishments that our ministers and volunteers continue to generate for our parish. I want our volunteers to hear that we are thankful, appreciative of their ministry.

Last year, around the parish feast day, we launched a volunteer sign-up in order to bring more support and grow our ministries. These planned All-Ministry Meetings are also meant to bring to the consciousness of our parishioners these opportunities to serve God. I sure hope that those who are still considering to take the leap of service may find these enrichment efforts as an encouragement for them as well.

My dear parish family, I ask you to please pray for our ministers and volunteers. May the Lord bless them a hundredfold for their generosity of talent, time and treasure in providing for their ministerial goals. I remember the Lord Jesus when he prayed for his disciples before ascending to heaven. In the Gospel of John, He addresses the Father and says these words that I wish to re-echo for our parish volunteers and ministers:

I revealed your name to those whom you gave me out of the world. They belonged to you, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything you gave me is from you, because the words you gave to me I have given to them, and they accepted them and truly understood that I came from you, and they have believed that you sent me. I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for the ones you have given me, because they are yours, and everything of mine is yours and everything of yours is mine, and I have been glorified in them. (John 17: 6-10)

These full ministry meetings are scheduled twice a year in our parish calendar, one in March and the other is September. I look forward with great expectations to sharing these moments with the people that make our parish excellent, alive and well. God bless our parish!

Dear Parishioners of St. Michael Parish.

Phase 3 of the Targeted Restructuring process, which included parishes in DuPage, Will and Grundy counties, is now complete. The Diocesan Targeted Restructuring Committee began this third phase in April of 2024 and over the next eight months, the Committee engaged in an intentional process to determine the future of these parishes. On December 20th I received the Committee's recommendations. After much prayer and discernment, I have decided to accept the Committee's recommendations. On February 13, 2025, I consulted with our Presbyteral Council, in accord with Canon Law. The Presbyteral Council unanimously approved my acceptance of the restructuring recommendations for Phase 3.

Accordingly, I have rendered the following decision:

- St. Mark in Wheaton will amalgamate into St. Michael in Wheaton.
- St. Mark church will remain open as a worship site.

These changes will go into effect as of July 1, 2025. There will be much information shared with your pastor and parish leadership regarding the next steps, and the support that will be provided by the Diocese. I encourage you to read all the information concerning the restructuring process and decisions on the Diocesan website. You will find on the website my official decision, a video about the process and answers to a number of frequently asked questions, including the definition of church terms that we use in these decisions.

I want you to know I have listened to you. I have heard and read your concerns and reservations. I have humbly witnessed your faith devotion, your personal sacrifices and your parish commitment. Be assured the TRC and I considered with respect your input, insights and suggestions. And while I am confident these decisions are the right ones for the future of the Church, I understand these results are very difficult when they directly affect you and your family. Change is hard. The changes may affect where you worship, how far you need to drive to attend mass or participate in parish events, and what you consider to be your intimate faith community. I appreciate these decisions may cause you to be sad and lead to a time of grieving.

During the parish sessions last year, the following scripture was shared, which I hope provides you solace:

"Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way." (John 14:1-7)

Thank you for your love of Jesus Christ and your commitment to His Church. With great faith and hope, let us ask the Holy Spirt to bless, lead, and guide us in these next steps within the Diocese of Joliet. May God bless you today and always.
