

# EMBRACING LENT IN PRAYER, FASTING AND ALMSGIVING

A Blessed Lenten Season, my dear St. Michael parish family! Every year, we journey this special season beginning with Ash Wednesday and concluding with the Holy Triduum. When we look back at the many times we have observed this season, can we say that it has helped us become better followers of Jesus? Has Lent ever really made a difference in our Christianity?

Whatever your answer is, this year's Lent offers us another opportunity to embrace the solemn devotions and practices of the season. And as we have heard the Gospel message on Ash Wednesday, there are indeed three areas that we can focus on: prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Through prayer, we seek the presence of God more intimately, allowing Him to shape our hearts. This season particularly invites us to traditional devotions like the Stations of the Cross, which we pray here at St. Michael every Friday at 7:00 PM. We also are invited to pray our sorrow for our sins through penitential prayers like the seven penitential psalms found in the Bible: Psalm 6, Psalm 32, Psalm 38, Psalm 51, Psalm 102, Psalm 130 and Psalm 143. Penitential psalms make fitting prayers for the repentant sinner during the season of Lent. There are many other prayer forms that are used during this season, including the meditation on the Seven Last Words of Jesus Christ, the reading of the Passion, and most of all, the celebration of the holy mass focusing on the spiritual themes of the season.

Through fasting, we discipline our desires, reminding ourselves that man does not live by bread alone but by every word from the mouth of God. Abstaining from meat on Fridays is a way of sacrifice. Although it is not required by the church anymore, it is encouraged that those who are able, should fast on Fridays as well. But there are many other observances of sacrifices, including the usual tradition of "giving up something for Lent" which when taken seriously can really teach us the value of self-control, of making a sacrificial offering to God for the atonement of sin, and to focus on spiritual virtues and habits of holiness.

Through almsgiving, we extend His mercy to those in need, embodying His love in the world. At the heart of almsgiving is the focus on generosity of spirit, which is done "in imitatio Dei" – that is, in the spirit of God's generosity for humanity by giving us His Son to redeem the world. We become like God through our acts of almsgiving, of generosity toward others especially the poor and the needy. I appreciate the fact that it is in the beginning of the Lenten Season that we launch the Diocesan Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal, because that is indeed an opportunity to extend our generosity to others, through the ministry of the Catholic Church of Joliet. We impact so many areas of giving by giving support to this one diocesan cause. In other ways of looking, almsgiving is also expressed through random acts of kindness, the giving of our goodness, loving hearts, good will towards others. These are equally if not even more meaningful ways of imitating God's action during lent.

As we enter this sacred season of Lent, let us not treat it as mere tradition but as a divine invitation to renewal. Lent is a time of grace, a season to turn our hearts back to God with greater fervor, humility, and love. It is a journey of repentance, reflection, and transformation—a time to strip away distractions and fix our gaze upon Christ, who gave Himself for our salvation.

Let this be a season where we die to sin and rise to new life. Let us not grow weary but embrace these forty days with purpose, knowing that beyond the cross lies the victory of the Resurrection. Christ calls us to walk with  $\operatorname{Him} - \operatorname{will}$  we answer? Now is the time for renewal. Now is the time for conversion. Let us walk in faith together here at saint Michael during this holy season.



Fr. Sunny was ordained a priest on June 5, 2004, only the second Filipino to be ordained for the Diocese of Joliet, and is currently the pastor at Saint Michael Church in Wheaton, IL. Prior to this, he was given the charge of consolidating three parishes in Kankakee where he also served as pastor - Saint Teresa, Saint Martin, and Saint Rose. In July 2017, he became the founding pastor of St. John Paul II Parish also in Kankakee. Prior to these pastorate assignments, he served as parochial vicar at Saint Mary Immaculate in Plainfield, Saint Michael in Wheaton and Saint Dominic in Bolingbrook. He was also appointed by Bishop Ronald Hicks as the Coordinator of Ongoing Formation of Priests in the Joliet Diocese starting in August of 2022.
