A TEACHING MASS FOR OUR YOUTH AND A LENTEN MISSION FOR OUR PARISH

In the Lenten Season, we find many opportunities to grow in our faith and devotion. We simply have to plug in with these opportunities, and let God do the holy work of renewing, sanctifying, growing and fructifying of our lives. This weekend, a back-to-back offering is available for you, my dear parishioners, to continue to excel in your walk of faith. And so, I want to take this bulletin column as an opportunity to invite you to these great observances for a more meaningful Lenten Season.

YOUTH GROUP TEACHING MASS. Honestly, I am not always very comfortable about the idea of a teaching Mass. You see, the Mass is itself a teaching, because we do learn so much by being immersed into it. By participating in prayer, song and ritual, we allow ourselves to learn the mysteries that envelop our experience of the Catholic liturgy. Add to that discomfort the fact that when I celebrate Mass, my disposition is primarily to pray, but the teaching Mass will have to interrupt the rhythm of my prayer so that I can draw attention and mindfulness to the parts of the Mass, as they happen. In that sense, it will drastically impose upon the solemnity of my prayer because I will need to interject the commentary and teaching between the breaths and pauses of my role as the presider. BUT I WILL MAKE THIS SACRIFICE THIS WEEKEND because I do believe that many people can benefit from a better understanding of the transcendent and profound moments that happen during Mass. So, this Sunday afternoon, March 23 at 4:30 PM, I will celebrate a teaching Mass in church with the youth, although it is open to anyone who wants to experience it. For this Mass, we will also give our Youth Band an opportunity to serve as music ministers for the first time. For the rest of our parish, I just want to ask that you lift our young parishioners in your prayer. May this special liturgy allow them to connect better with the incarnations of the Divine God and respond well through the opportunities to pray, sing and ritualize their worship.

CHALICE MINISTRIES PARISH MISSION WITH CHRIS BRAY. The blurb says, "Join us for an invigorating, joyous and deeply Eucharistic two-night mission as we listen and learn to encounter Christ more deeply and empower ourselves to share and live our faith with others..." That's all I need to know for me to be excited about going! A joyous Eucharistic mission?! Let's go! I have not really met Chris Bray in person, but I have checked out some materials on YouTube and I find him very enthusiastic and super talented. He will be bringing his music and lively talks to this mission, and so I am pumped to have a dose of inspiration and encouragement to continue in my walk of faith, especially during Lent. The mission begins this evening, March 23, at 6:30 PM and will continue tomorrow, Monday, at the same time. This mission is a re-echoing of the message and spirit that last year's national Eucharistic Congress brought to many Catholics in the country. So, I invite you to let the Spirit move you tonight and let God infuse new energy and life into your Lenten journey. I pray most of all that our parish mission will help us appreciate more the splendor of the sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist.

Blessings and peace to you!

As we begin our Lenten journey, marked by prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, I am writing to inform you of two identical pieces of legislation that would legalize assisted suicide in Illinois: SB 9 and HB 1328. Please consider offering your prayers and fasting to help stop this. In addition, take action by writing, calling, or emailing your state elected officials to vote "NO" on this legislation. For further information, visit www.ilcatholic.org or call 217-528-9200.

Assisted suicide would make it legal for a physician to prescribe a range of lethal drugs to a person diagnosed with a terminal disease who requests to end his or her life.

It is alarming that in states where suicide is legalized, there are documented cases of people being denied life-saving medical treatment by insurance companies in favor of the much cheaper option of life-ending drugs. The poor and those with disabilities are particularly at risk, as they are the most vulnerable to such abuses. Every major national organization that represents people with disabilities opposes assisted suicide. There is no way to prevent the vulnerable from being coerced or intimidated into ending their lives once assisted suicide is legal.

The American Medical Association (AMA) has summed up the case against assisted suicide well: "Physician-assisted suicide is fundamentally incompatible with the physician's role as healer, would be difficult or impossible to control, and would pose serious societal risks."

Proponents argue that this legislation will end suffering at the end of life. As Catholics, we agree that no one should needlessly suffer or have to watch a loved one experience unnecessary pain. Fortunately, there are now effective ways to make a person more comfortable at the end of life through palliative care.

Assisted suicide is not the compassionate solution for those who are suffering. Through palliative care, expanded access to mental health care, and stronger family and community support, providers and families are finding better ways to accompany these individuals compassionately — ways that truly reflect the love for and dignity of each human life.

Through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, let us continue to pray for respect and dignity for human life from conception to natural death.





Spiritual Adoption

As we near the Feast of the Annunciation, when it was announced to our Mother, Mary, that she would bear the Christ child, the St. Michael School Lancers for Life Club and the St. Michael Parish Respect Life Committee wanted to provide you and your family an opportunity to participate in a spiritual adoption prayer campaign along with the parish community. This program is a simple, yet effective pro-life activity that involves components of prayer, education, and outreach. The first step involves pledging to pray for the protection of a baby in the womb starting on the Feast of the Annunciation, March 25th.

We encourage you to give a name to the unborn baby you are praying for as a simple reminder that you are asking God to protect the life and health of a specific baby in his/her mother's womb whose life and health may be in danger.

Below is a prayer/pledge card written by the Venerable Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen. Please cut out the prayer card for you to keep and use to pray daily for the baby you have "adopted." Additionally, cut out the pledge heart and send it back to RE office as a pledge that you will pray daily for the next nine months. Your pledge hearts will be posted in the RE building as a sign that you and your family are praying for these innocent unborn babies.







