## OUR CATECHUMENS AND CANDIDATES (Part 1): Getting Ready to Embrace the Catholic Faith!

Some great things have been happening here at Saint Michael Parish! I am very excited because this year, we will see one the biggest number of catechumens and candidates to be fully received into the Church through the OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) Program of our parish in recent years.

When I arrived here at Saint Michael's, it was brought to my attention that we needed to re-evaluate the program for the OCIA. One afternoon, Colleen Brodhead and I sat down, and just typed away with the flow of topics for the new program, added the possible resources that may be associated with each topic and discerned who may

be able to offer those specific topics to be presented to the "class" and voila, a new curriculum for our parish was born. I was blown away by how fast we managed to create the curriculum, and I can only attribute it to the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. Then when time came to invite people to this year's journey to full initiation in the Church, we found a growing number of people who wanted to join us. As the program stabilized, after a few drops due to understandable reasons and some later additions, we ended up with a record-breaking number of twenty. I would like to introduce first the five catechumens who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil.

Here are some simple facts about each of them:

**RAQUEL CARBONE.** She is a first grade teacher of St. Michael School here in Wheaton, although she grew up in West Chicago! She enjoys cooking, playing pickleball, and traveling, especially to her favorite destination in Montana. Most of all, she loves spending time with her husband Andrew and their dog Bailey.

**SAMANTHA CARROLL.** Samantha is a mother of four little girls aged five, four and two years old, and one that is newborn at three months. The youngest was born when she was already in the OCIA program. One of her two sisters, Katrina Lovelass, is sharing with her the experience of being fully initiated in the Catholic Church. Samantha loves being a fulltime mom but in her free time, she also enjoys reading and doing crafts like sewing and painting.

**ANGEL CASTANEDA.** Angel is a parishioner of Saint James in Glen Ellyn, but he grew up in Harvard, IL. He is a quality engineer by profession. In his free time, he enjoys working out in the gym and loves going away on vacation to Cancun, Mexico. He went through our OCIA program but will be baptized on Easter at his parish together with Zach Fasick.

**ZACH FASICK.** Zach is also a Saint James parishioner and will receive his sacraments of initiation there during the Easter Vigil. He works as an athletic coach and high school teacher. Zach enjoys the outdoors especially hunting and fishing, and watching "The Chosen". His favorite Christian song is "Awesome God."

**KATRINA LOVELASS.** Katrina is currently a Saint Michael parishioner although she grew up in Selah, Washington. No wonder she still prefers to go westward for vacation, particularly the Oregon Coast. Katrina has two sisters, one of whom is Samantha Carroll, who is also getting baptized this year. Katrina is currently working as a hairstylist.

I pray that these final weeks of preparation into the sacraments of initiation prove to be a time of great joy and inspiration. May the Holy Spirit grow their hunger for Jesus, and for the spiritual union with the Church. Please pray for them in a special way that the faith that they are given by God and the sacraments that they will receive from His Church may abundantly serve as a spring of grace in their lives.



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon our diocese will take up The Catholic Relief Services Collection. The Become a Shepherd program is a parish-based awareness campaign that educates lay and religious leaders to recognize human trafficking and combat it through public engagement and advocacy at the community level. The second initiative, COMPASS (Coalition of Organizations and Ministries Promoting the Abolition of Slavery at Sea), is a global effort in which international Catholic and non-Catholic partners coordinate to identify and assist victims of modern slavery encountered in the commercial fishing and seafood-processing industries.

The invaluable work to assist these victims of abuse and injustice is supported by funds received through The Catholic Relief Services Collection. Your participation helps MRS and five other Catholic ministries to reveal Christ's love to victims of trafficking, war, and natural disaster both around the world and here in the United States. 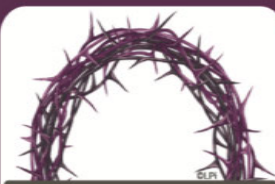


## LENTEN DISCIPLINES OF FASTING & ABSTINENCE

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.
