

## Fr. Santos 'Sunny' Castillo - From the pastor's desk

#### **DIVINE MERCY: FROM HEAVEN TO YOU!**

When I arrived here at St. Michael in 2007, the devotion to the Divine Mercy was already strong, and I remember the long lines of confessions and the feeling of being tired after everything was done for the feast. This year is no different, I can see. Our parish continues to have a strong devotion to the Sorrowful Passion as we observe this weekend the Feast of the Divine Mercy.

On this second Sunday of Easter, it is a privilege that we are given an opportunity to recommit to the abundant love of God. I have seen the actual image of the Divine Mercy in Krakow a couple of times, and I testify to the power of the image. It does seem like Jesus is in the flesh; that's how real the image looks. But that's not so much the image as it is because Jesus is real, and His mercy is real. Jesus Himself is present in and through this special image. I believe that the world is in dire need of the message of this feast day, and in our community, this is something of great significance in every aspect of our lives. Who does not need God's Mercy? Who does not desire his life that He won for us, therefore making the Easter Season a time of great joy and triumph over sin and death? Who does not need to be renewed by the grace that only Jesus can give?

And He is present in the very essence of His messages to Sr. Faustina Kowalska. Consider these excerpts to reflect on this weekend:

The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls... These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross... These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father. Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him...

I desire the first Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy... Ask of my faithful servant [Father Sopocko] that, on this day, he tell the whole world of My great mercy; that whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment.

Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy... Oh, how much I am hurt by a soul's distrust! Such a soul professes that I am Holy and Just, but does not believe that I am Mercy and does not trust in My Goodness. My Heart rejoices in this title of Mercy... Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God... All the works of My hands are crowned with mercy."

The DEATH OF POPE FRANCIS. As a parish family, in union with the entire family of God in the Church, let us commend to the divine mercy of God our deceased pontiff Francis. The hallmark of his papacy was the all-embracing holy love which he extended to everyone, not just the faithful people of the Church, but in a godly way, even to the ones that are considered as outsiders, the marginalized, the poor and the victims of injustice. The heart of this merciful pope gave us a glimpse of the mercy of God, and we can only imagine. May he rest in peace.
