PASTOR'S PROMISE and GRATITUDE

Last Sunday, at the 10:45 Mass, the solemn rite of installation of pastor was presided by Bishop Ronald Hicks. As I look back to the day's events and the things that took place then, my heart is overwhelmed with gratitude and appreciation.

The actual rite of installation, as some of you commented after Mass, does sound very imposing, highfalutin, demanding, and maybe overwhelming. And in case we do not realize, it is not a joke, not to be taken light-heartedly. Perhaps, for the purpose of this article, allow me to break down three important promises that are made by the pastor during the rite of installation:


- Promise of Fidelity. To remain faithful to the teachings of the Church. As a teacher of the faith, the pastor indeed, teaches not his own ideas or opinions but the teachings of the entire Church, the magisterium. And since no person knows everything about the full compendium of faith and doctrine, then the pastor is expected to be continually learning, growing in understanding. To remain faithful also means to be diligent in the task of pastoral ministry, because this is the primary work of every priest, the salvation of souls.
- Promise of Service. To save souls and look after the sanctification of the people under his care, the pastor is called as a spiritual shepherd on behalf of the bishop. As the pastor, I embody the depth of this spiritual responsibility. The task is expressed in our prayerfulness, in our availability, and in our commitment to bring hope, healing, divine mercy, and compassion to every person who walks through the doors of the church. To any person, this is of course, a very overwhelming task, but I know that the Lord always provides the grace necessary for the mission.
- Promise of Holiness. Bishop Hicks, indeed, in his homily, summarized his exhortation by inviting me to live a holy life as your pastor. Holiness has a way of influencing people from within. In the words of St. Francis, my favorite saint, holiness is to always preach the Gospel of Jesus, and if necessary, use words. Holiness is life and a living witness, and every priest is called to such ideal.

WORDS OF GRATITUDE. At this juncture, I want to express my gratitude to the staff and volunteers that helped in the celebration last weekend. I felt the Holy Spirit present in our midst. The liturgy was beautiful, and the efforts of every liturgical minister is a gift, and I am grateful, beginning with our bishop Most Reverend Ronald Hicks and his emcee Deacon Bob Misiunas, priests Fr. Jacob, Fr. Dindo Billote and Fr. Joe Gasta (who concelebrated at mass), our deacons Dan Simmet and Dan Aderholdt, and Deacon Candidate Mike Doerries. Being with the parish staff and parish council members was such a symbolic moment in the liturgy and rite. I want to thank each of them for their generosity and support. Thanks to all our liturgical ministers, our mass coordinators Cathy, Peggy and Maribeth, our parish choir and music ministers led by Dr. Kevin Ballard for their incredibly uplifting work, the Knights of Columbus who graced our liturgy with their service as honor guards. I also want to say thank you to Keith Larson (of PJ's Camera & Photo Supply) for his photo coverage. The fellowship that followed was beautiful and filled with goodness. Thanks to Mary Marten for her planning, and for all those that helped make the celebration beautiful. Thanks also to many of my family and friends who joined in prayer and celebration, including those that brought the Filipino desserts; so awesome.

Thanks to you, my Saint Michael family, for your unfailing love and welcome to this priest from the other side of the world, whom you have embraced from then 'til now as part of your spiritual family. God bless you all and thank you for the privilege of being your pastor.
