### TO BE A CHURCH OF THE PENTECOST

May the peace of Christ and the joy of the Holy Spirit fill your hearts today, as we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the birthday of the Church.

From the moment of Pentecost, when tongues of fire descended on the apostles and the Church was born, the Holy Spirit has never ceased to breathe life into the Body of Christ. He is not simply a distant power or poetic metaphor—He is the **third Person of the Trinity**, the **indwelling presence of God**, the Spirit of the Risen Christ living in His Church and in each of us. The Catechism teaches that "the Holy Spirit is the principal agent of the Church's mission" (CCC 852). Every act of evangelization, every sacrament received, every conversion of heart is first and foremost a work of the Spirit. He is the one who **unites us**, **sanctifies us**, and **sends us**. But the Spirit does not force Himself upon us. He invites us into relationship. And like any relationship, it must be cultivated with attentiveness, reverence, and love. As such, we are meant to be a Church of the Holy Spirit. **But how, then, can we at St. Michael Parish grow closer to the Holy Spirit and be a Church of the Pentecost?** 

Here are a few ways:

- **Pray daily to the Holy Spirit.** Begin or end your day with the simple but powerful prayer: "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love." Ask the Spirit to guide your decisions, enlighten your understanding, and strengthen your witness.
- **Read and pray with the Acts of the Apostles.** The Book of Acts is the Gospel of the Holy Spirit. It shows how ordinary people, filled with the Spirit, lived boldly for Christ. Form a Bible study or prayer group focused on Acts. Let it spark new fire in your hearts.
- **Participate fully in the sacramental life.** The Spirit is poured out in Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. Frequent reception of the sacraments—especially the Eucharist and Reconciliation—opens us more deeply to the Spirit's transformative power.
- **Be open to the charisms the Spirit gives.** St. Paul reminds us that "to each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good" (1 Cor 12:7). Whether it's teaching, hospitality, healing, encouragement, or service—discover your spiritual gifts and use them to build up our parish community.
- **Create space for silence.** The Spirit often speaks not in noise but in the stillness. Make time each day for quiet prayer, Lectio Divina, or simply sitting in the presence of God. Consider joining or forming a small contemplative prayer group.
- Let the Spirit lead you in love and mission. Look for opportunities to serve with joy. Whether through our outreach ministries, visiting the homebound, mentoring the youth, or simply showing compassion at work or school—the Holy Spirit is present wherever love is active and selfless.

St. Michael, the Archangel, is our parish patron, protector, defender, and servant of God's kingdom. May we follow his example in courage and faith, trusting that the Spirit of God is already at work in us.

Let us be a parish alive in the Spirit: a community of discernment, communion, and mission.

May our worship be Spirit-filled, our service Spirit-led, and our hearts ever open to the God who walks with us.

Come, Holy Spirit, and renew the face of the earth—beginning with us.
