

### A TRANSITION FOR CHRISTOPHER ORF

With heartfelt gratitude, we thank Chris Orf for his many years of dedicated service to St. Michael Parish as both Director of Music and Liturgy. Since 2007, Chris has faithfully led our community in sung prayer and reverent worship. His devotion to the liturgy, his musical excellence, and his care for preparing each celebration have deeply enriched our parish life. Through his leadership, Chris has helped shape our liturgies with beauty, dignity, and pastoral sensitivity—ensuring that each Mass was a true encounter with the sacred. His legacy will remain in the voices he nurtured, the prayers he helped lift, and the spirit of worship he cultivated among us. As Chris concludes his ministry at the end of June 2025, we invite the parish community to a tribute reception in his honor on Saturday, June 28, following the 5:00 PM Mass. Let us come together to thank him and celebrate the many gifts he has shared over the years. We are also pleased to announce that Dr. Kevin Ballard, Chris's longtime associate, will assume the role of Director of Sacred Music. We look forward to the continued growth of our music ministry under his leadership. Chris, thank you for your music, your heart, and your steadfast dedication to the liturgy. You have been a blessing to St. Michael Parish, and we are forever grateful.

### **WILLOW STREET PROJECT**

We are excited to share a significant step forward in the Willow Street Project! Last Monday, our parish team presented our petition to the Wheaton City Council, requesting the vacation of Willow Street between West Avenue and Wheaton Avenue—a move that would unify the campus of St. Michael Parish. We are pleased to report that the City Council unanimously approved the drafting of the ordinance to vacate the street. This milestone brings us closer to a safer, more connected parish and school environment. We extend our heartfelt thanks to everyone who has played a role in this process: the Buildings and Grounds Committee, the School and Faith Formation leadership, Mary Marten, and all who have offered their expertise, support, and prayer. We are especially grateful to the City of Wheaton for their unwavering support and partnership in this vision for our parish community. The next City Council meeting will focus on the approval of the ordinance. As we move forward, we ask you to continue to pray for wisdom, unity, and a spirit of collaboration as we work toward this shared goal.

### PARISH FACILITIES AND STEWARDSHIP UPDATE ~ An Invitation to Support the Care of Our Campus

As part of our continued effort to be faithful stewards of our parish campus, I would like to share with you several important updates regarding recent and ongoing projects aimed at preserving and improving our buildings and grounds. This fiscal year, we have undertaken two major <u>unbudgeted</u> projects that were necessary for the safety and upkeep of our campus:

### Pavement Replacement at the St. Michael Statue (\$44,000)

The bricks surrounding the St. Michael statue at the corner of West Avenue and Illinois Street had deteriorated due to heavy foot traffic, becoming a recurring hazard. We have replaced the area with a durable, non-slip pavement, ensuring both safety and longevity.

### **Urgent Gymnasium Roof Replacement (\$154,750)**

A recent inspection found the gymnasium roof to be in very poor condition, requiring immediate replacement to prevent further damage. The tear-off and replacement of the 8,600-square-foot roof is now underway and is currently 25% complete, with full completion expected within the week.

Because these two projects were not included in our current fiscal budget, I humbly invite our parishioners to prayerfully consider making a special contribution to help offset these unexpected costs. Every gift—no matter the size—helps us protect and sustain the spaces where we worship, learn, and gather as a community. Please be assured that we remain fully committed to responsible management of our facilities and resources. These efforts are possible because of your continued generosity, trust, and partnership in our shared mission. Thank you for all the ways you support our parish. May God bless you abundantly.






## **HOLY NAME SOCIETY**
