

ONE SAINT MICHAEL:One Parish, One Mission, One Campus

On Monday, July 21, 2025, Saint Michael Parish reached a historic milestone. The City Council of Wheaton unanimously voted to approve the vacation of Willow Street, the block that currently divides our parish into two separate campuses. This decision officially sets in motion the unification of our parish grounds under one continuous and accessible space.

We truly believe that the **hand of God** has guided this entire process. Who would have imagined that when Second Hand Rose closed, and later when the adjacent bank property was placed on the market, we would one day be in the position to request and receive approval for the vacation of Willow Street? And yet, by God's providence and your continued prayers and support, it has happened.

Next Steps in the Project

Completion of Engineering and Site Development Plans. Final engineering plans will address site grading, drainage, utility relocation, and full campus reconfiguration. Enhancements will include improved traffic flow, ADA compliance, pedestrian safety features, and beautiful landscaping—all designed to support a more unified and welcoming parish environment.

Seeking Diocesan Approval. The project will be presented to the Diocesan Buildings and Grounds Committee on September 23, 2026. This essential step ensures pastoral alignment and compliance with diocesan building policies.

Commencement of Capital Campaign. We will launch a Capital Campaign to raise an estimated \$2.5 to \$2.7 million to fund the unification project. All parishioners will be invited to participate through prayerful giving. Naming and memorial opportunities will be available to recognize significant donors and legacy gifts.

City of Wheaton Infrastructure Improvements. Starting June 1, 2026, the City of Wheaton will begin infrastructure improvements along Willow Street. These improvements—coordinated in advance with our parish—will prepare the area for seamless integration with our campus development plans.


