# **Answers to Questions and Comments About our Liturgies**

As we begin the month of August and see things come back to life from a more relaxed summer season, I want to welcome many of our parishioners who have been gone for short or extended time during the summer months. In this bulletin article, I want to answer some questions that have been asked during the First Leadership Vision Meeting of our parish in May. Some of those questions have been answered already as we responded by the things that have been done over the spring and summer months. Here, I will respond to some questions and suggestions that were made.

- Is it possible to move the 8:00 AM Mass to 10:00 AM during the week? As far as the rhythm of the parish is concerned, our mornings are usually very busy. By the time it is 10:00 AM, we are usually working on many other aspects of the parish, and in many cases, a funeral Mass is already happening at 10:00 AM. Add to that the things that go on in the parking lot early in the morning, my gut feeling is that a 10:00 AM daily Mass will create a lot of conflicts in the life of the parish. So yes, it is possible, but it is not deemed advisable, especially for a very busy parish like ours.
- People need to know more what is happening in the sacrifice of the Mass. Maybe do some sort of teaching at each Mass as part of the homily. I share the concern about people's need to understand more what is going on at Mass. But I am apprehensive about the idea of using the Mass as a "tool" or "platform" for teaching, because primarily, that is not why we go to Mass. Having said that, I have done many Masses where I interject a teaching or two about the Mass in my homily. My general hunch is to regularly provide opportunities for learning outside of Mass, and perhaps online resources on the richness of the Catholic liturgy. Our parish FORMED subscription and other online sources provide a plethora of excellent videos and information on this topic these days.
- Can the prayer of St. Michael be added to Sundays before the recessional hymn? We do this in the morning, at the end of every daily Mass. It is incumbent upon us that the Prayer to Saint Michael is OUR prayer. However, devotional prayers are not supposed to be added as if they were actually part of the Mass. I feel that the best response to this is to schedule various prayers throughout the year that can be prayed after the dismissal. (Because guess what, while I have received requests to pray the St. Michael Prayer, I have also received requests about praying the Hail Mary, and then praying a Vocations Prayer, and then praying the Anima Christi Prayer.) So, for example, in the month of September, we will pray the Saint Michael Prayer, then in the month of October we will pray the Memorare, rotating them monthly. However, everyone is encouraged to pray their own devotional prayers anytime, before or after the Mass.
- Can we change the Mass from 7:15 AM to 7:30 AM? I understand that 15 years ago, when I was an associate, the first Sunday Mass was at 7:30 AM, and it was only in the Covid years that it changed to 7:15 AM to allow more time for the clean-up and setup protocols. I find the 7:15 AM time a bit off myself. My brain wants to round off things to the hour or to the thirty minutes. However, as we have played with various options to accommodate the Family Faith Formation program, we found the necessity to keep the 7:15 AM schedule as it is, even though we could and had to change the 10:45 AM Mass to the 11:00 AM schedule. So, whenever I get to do the 7:15 AM Mass feeling off about the 15 minutes, I just surrender it to the Lord as a sacrifice. In a world where problems abound, this is one I can just charge to a holy offering.
- Have children more involved in Masses. Thank you! That is one of the things that we (i.e., the leadership teams and I) are always thinking to do more of, not only in encouraging our young to be at Mass and grow in their appreciation of the sacred Mass, but in many aspects of their community life as well. By our efforts to revive the children's choir soon (thanks Dr. Kevin Ballard!), to incorporate Mass attendance in the Faith Formation program, to offer an extra afternoon Mass once a month where the youth group and the junior high may serve and worship together with the rest of the community, among others, that we are continually achieving this.
- Can we add a cancer support group? That is a great idea. Since the office of parish nurse has been eliminated, I see that we have been left with gaps on opportunities to do more pastoral care work. Deacon Dan Aderholdt has been spearheading efforts of this kind in our parish, but he needs as much support as possible. If anyone reading this feels so moved to facilitate this and other kinds of support groups, please reach out to me. If you have any background in counseling, therapy, psychology and the like, your parish needs you. Thank you!

I will answer more questions and comments at another time. But thank you for these, and I appreciate the ongoing communication and dialogue. It means that we are all concerned and invested in our parish. God bless Saint Michael Church!







# Important Update for Parishioners: Action Required Regarding CMAA InPew Envelopes

The Development Office of the Diocese of Joliet is committed to maintaining transparency and open communication with our parishioners. We wish to provide an important update concerning the status of the Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal (CMAA) InPew Envelopes.

As many of you are aware, we encountered an unexpected challenge with UPS back in

March, which resulted in the loss of 23 packages containing InPew Envelopes, many with checks made out to the CMAA. To date, UPS has been unable to locate these missing packages. In light of this situation, we strongly



advise parishioners who made a gift via check using an InPew Envelope to verify their transaction with their bank.

If you find that your check has not been cashed, we recommend you take the necessary steps to stop payment on that check.
