MORE THAN JUST A PARISH PICNIC

I remember those years when our parish picnic happened at Herrick Lake. I was an associate pastor, and the new church was newly dedicated. We took a full section of the lakeside, and celebrated a Mass there, followed by a parish cookout with burgers and brats, ice cream and drinks. People came with excitement and a sense of gratitude for belonging to the Saint Michael parish family. There was an obvious pride deep within the spirit of the picnic. It was one I always looked forward to.

But why a parish picnic? Is this just one of those things that we have been accustomed to do, and lost sense of the purpose and reason why we do them? Last year, I remember giving out ice cream bars, and I was excited, being reintroduced to our parish fifteen long years since I finished my assignment as associate pastor with Fr. Don McLaughlin. I took note of some new faces, and was glad to meet new families, while wondering what happened to the many that I no longer see, the people who have passed, but also the people who have moved to other parishes, or have stopped connecting with the community over the years. I also noticed that by the time I was done giving out the ice cream bars, the parish picnic was also done. Barely a few tables still had some people winding down their conversations. It was over so quickly, it was over before it was over.

Our parish picnic is one that is meant to **build community, to reach out to one another in a casual environment, to get to know the people who sit around us during the Mass**. It is a time to make a few steps in a feeling of belonging to each other. It is a chance to get to know someone else who might be on the other side of the church or may attend a different Mass altogether on the weekend. Yes, it is an **intentional attempt to tighten our community spirit** and to become more familiar with each other.

I also hope that our parish picnic becomes an **opportunity to look back at the efforts and legacies of the many who have gone before us**. It is a celebration of what they have done. It is a picnic of gratitude. We stand here today as St. Michael parish through the generosity and vision of those who were here before us, beginning with the priests and religious who served here, to the founding families and volunteers that have kept the life of the parish flowing. I remember when I was working on the About Us section of our newly redeveloped parish website, rereading the history of our church. It was obvious that there were many more people who were part of the story, but the broad strokes of memory were enough for me to thank God for each person that made us who we are today. I remembered Fr. Don who passed away on August 6, barely two years ago, and the story of how our current parish church building rose from the ashes of the wooden church that was destroyed by the fire of 2002. Let us **thank the generations of the past for their imprints of faith** that continue to inspire the community of today.




