

God delights in you. How do you feel when you hear that? Delight usually comes with an exuberant flow of joy that seemingly arises from one's toes with the expression of great glee. A very young brother and sister were playing on the beach when the all too familiar ice cream truck made its daily rounds. 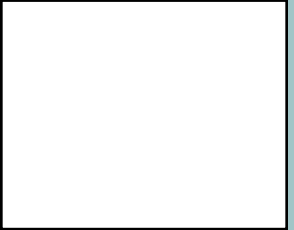

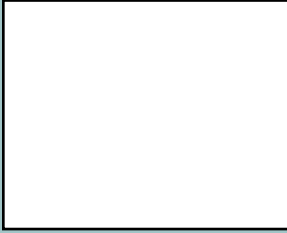
