




*Confirmation: teens in public, parochial, and home school seeking the sacrament of Confirmation MUST REGISTER NOW for classes held in the spring of 2026.



Topics such as sports, hobbies, politics, fitness, the economy, and pop culture were some of the themes. I did a lot of head nodding, smiling, and trying to stay engaged. Don't get me wrong, I really did enjoy the interaction with the person, but something in me had changed.

What conversations are most important to me? What conversations should be most important to me? Am I most concerned about winning the victory of the Kingdom or of winning in the world? Now you're in on the conversation. I wonder what your reaction will be? Our Lady of Victory, pray for us!


