#### THE MAZZUCHELLI CAUSE -

#### St. John the Evangelist Founder

"On July 6, 1993, Father Samuel Mazzuchelli was declared 'Venerable' by His Holiness Pope John Paul II. This is the first step to canonization or official Church recognition of his sanctity. Rome formerly acknowledged that his virtues were heroic: 'Beyond doubt' Father Samuel exemplified the theological virtues of prudence, justice, fortitude, and



temperance. The title 'Venerable' was granted in response to a former request made to Rome thirty years before, in 1964. The next step toward canonization is being named 'Blessed'." His portrait now hangs in the SW corner of church.

#### **On Our Journey**

**Resisting Temptation** – There are five things widely accepted in the Church that will help us to resist temptation and keep the devil and his demons at bay. I would like to briefly touch on those. The first thing is to regularly pray the rosary, or as Saint Padre Pio would say, pray with your spiritual weapon. The rosary invites us into the Good News of Jesus Christ and puts us under the mantle of Our Lady's protection. The second thing is to wear or carry the Brown Scapular. Many promises come with the wearing of the Brown Scapular, but don't look at this as a good luck charm; rather, you are claiming your allegiance to whose side you're on. The Brown Scapular is a silent prayer to Mary for protection against temptation. Third, wear or carry with you (wearing it is more efficacious) the Miraculous Medal. Again, many graces are promised to those who wear the medal faithfully, but I suggest using your medal for protection from evil, conversion of lost souls, and a constant reminder to pray through Our Lady's intercession. Fourth, receive the Eucharist in a state of grace. We all know the importance of receiving Jesus Christ, body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist. The caveat, of course, is that we receive in a state of grace, so let's make sure we get to the Sacrament of Reconciliation regularly. Lastly, use sacramentals. Sacramentals are signs that remind us of the Sacraments. The first three things I mentioned in this article are sacramentals, as are holy water, blessed candles, blessed salt, statues, and ashes, among others. The bottom line is to use the gifts the Church has given us to fight temptation and the working of the Evil One in our lives.


