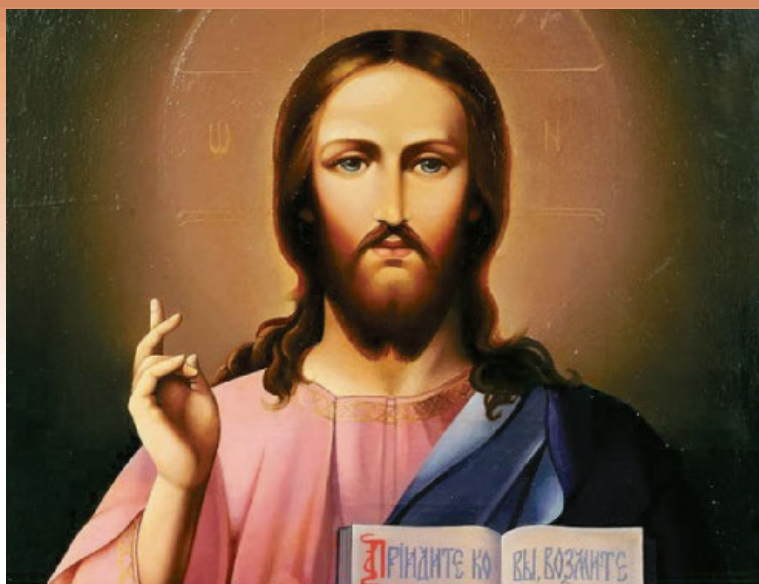

**Dear Sisters and Friends,**

The family from Guatemala have arrived in Tennessee and are safe and sound with an aunt of Brianalee. I had the good fortune to accompany them to the entrance gate at the border on Monday AM. It was a happy occasion for all of them, and only sad to say a final good-bye, and God be with you. You wish the very best for each one who has the chance to begin a new peaceful life together in new surroundings, and with many hopes and dreams, like good health for their little girl, and a chance for medical attention as needed. Thanks for your prayers for these migrants who are all precious and special.



One of the Sisters I have been living with, Sr. Tracey, a sister of Providence from Indianapolis, left this week for a 30-day retreat during the month of May in WI at Mary of the Woods in Arbor Vita, WI. She is preparing for her final vows in August. She asked for prayers for herself and her director, and I assured her that we have a great group of pray-ers in Manitowoc County! Thanks, in advance.

The week has been busy and full and the number of meals we are now serving jumped from 250 to 360 each day...that includes the 85-90 people in the shelter. So that means more pounds of potatoes to peel, and more onions to dice, more carrots to shred, and more tomatoes to slice....as well as more meat/fish to cut up on occasion. So our early AM 's are occupied getting ready for the next day's menu. The main reason for the increase is that more folks are coming back to Kino in response to phone calls from Kino's lawyers or they are anticipating that call. Most who have been here 6 months or longer, have a possible chance to present their case, and so they are eagerly waiting in the wings, so to speak. We hear already of some success stories, and that gives others hope.

Another new group of students arrived in the shelter, so again I have the chance to teach more of them some basics of English. I wish you could see their faces as they learn new vocabulary, and try their best to pronounce so many new words. We have some good laughs, esp. when I get mixed up, and forget which language I am speaking. This past week we got acquainted with parts of the city/ town and how to follow directions to find important places in "Gringolandia". They enjoyed my name for the town. I assured them they would get lost several times before they found their way around new places, but getting "un-lost" is important, too.

I heard a little hope for the Spring coming to WI lately...hopefully where you live. For those in other states, maybe it is already green and blossoms can be seen. Do take time to enjoy the nice weather, when it comes. Carve out some down time to take a walk and breathe deeply, or just be outside absorbing the pleasant breezes, etc. The month of May here will be rainy, they tell me, so we will see soon, I guess.

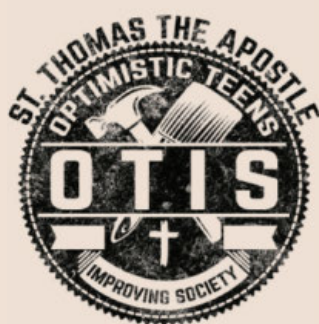

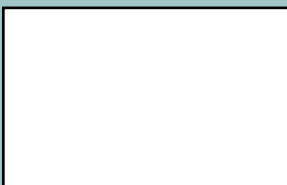

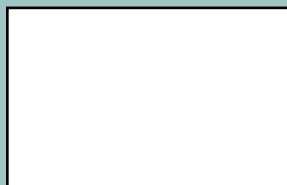
