## Pandemic Tax Tip: Non-Itemizers Can Deduct \$300 for Charity Donations in 2021

Be sure to take advantage of the special \$300 charitable-giving deduction that Congress authorized this spring in response to the pandemic. For the 2021 tax year, the charitable deduction is even better than it was in 2020, at least for those who file a joint return. For 2020, the charitable limit was \$300 per "tax unit" – meaning that those who are married and filing jointly can only get a \$300 deduction. For the 2021 tax year, however, those who are married and filing jointly can **each** take a \$300 deduction, for a total of \$600. Individuals still can also take advantage of the \$300 charitable-giving also in 2021.
