## Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist Revised Safety Guidelines – Effective June 1, 2021

- **Cathedral Capacity:** Entry to the Cathedral will no longer be subject to social distancing capacity.
- **Masks:** Masks will not be required to attend Mass at the Cathedral. However, during weekend Mass, there will be a reserved section on the east side of the Cathedral between the Altar and the Ambo where masks that cover the mouth and nose will be required. Masks will not be required if you are seated outside of this section.
- **Weekend Mass:** During weekend Masses, two entrances to the Cathedral will be open - the door off the Cathedral parking lot adjacent to the rectory garage (an accessible entrance with a ramp) and the center door off of Jackson Street. Other doors (including the side doors on Jackson) will remain locked. The two available doors will be unlocked half an hour before each scheduled Mass and will be locked after the start of Mass.
- **Weekday Mass:** During weekday Masses, only one entrance to the Cathedral will be open - the door off the Cathedral parking lot adjacent to the rectory garage (an accessible entrance with a ramp). The available door will be unlocked 15 minutes before Mass and will be locked after the start of Mass. Masks will be available, but they will not be required.
- **Sacrament of Reconciliation:** The use of the confessional will resume. Masks will be available, but will not be required. Only one entrance to the Cathedral will be open - the door off the Cathedral parking lot adjacent to the rectory garage (an accessible entrance with a ramp). The available door will be unlocked at 4:15 and locked at 5:00 pm.
- **Communion:** If you are seated in the reserved section during weekend Mass where masks are required, please remain at your seat during Communion. Communion will be distributed to individuals at their seats in the reserved section. If you are seated outside of this section, distribution of Communion will take place in front of the Altar.
  - ◇ Hand sanitizer will be available for use prior to the distribution of Communion.
  - ◇ Communion is to be received ONLY in the HAND.
  - ◇ Communion will not be distributed by the Cup.
- Anyone with fever or flu-like symptoms is asked to stay at home.
- Live-stream and radio broadcast of Mass from the Cathedral will remain available as it was prior to the pandemic. Please visit [stjohncathedral.org](http://stjohncathedral.org) for details.

Please keep in mind that these guidelines may be subject to change as the circumstances require. Additional directions will be given during Mass if necessary.

## From the desk of Fr Jose

Greetings parishioners,

Thank you for your perseverance, patience and prayer these past 14 months as we have dealt with the global pandemic of Covid-19.

The CDC has issued new guidelines regarding social distancing and the wearing of face coverings. With the recommendation from the Archbishop, we will begin to loosen the restrictions of this past year.

You may have noticed that the padded chairs are back (or will be soon)! The chairs have been professionally cleaned, sanitized and a protective coating has been applied before moving them back into the church. We have increased capacity to 300. Although, the chairs are not six feet apart, they are distanced to provide safety for all.

I am asking everyone to please be considerate of each other. The past 14 months, we have taken prudent and deliberate steps in ensuring the safety of our parishioners. We realize some people will not be comfortable in a public setting without face coverings or social distancing, but we must continue to treat everyone with dignity and respect. By slowly adding additional chairs, this will allow us to make the adjustments necessary to ensure everyone feels safe and comfortable.

This has been a long journey. I want to thank you again for your patience. We have tried to make decisions out of an abundance of caution. Even as things continue to reopen, I ask that you continue to respect our approach to ensure we continue to offer a safe and welcoming worship space for all of the people entrusted to our care.

Please know of our continued prayers for all of you.
