Prison Ministry

My dear Cathedral Parish Family and Friends,

As we begin to return to our normal lives, I would like to update you on what is happening with the Prison Ministry here at the Cathedral. We have begun to hold our "Doing Time Together" meetings again with the families of the incarcerated. We meet every second Saturday of the month from 9:30 to 10:45 am at the parish offices. The families are very grateful for this time when they can come together, to express what is happening in their lives in a secure and confidential setting.

We have also branched out to assist the Milwaukee Secure Detention Center, located in downtown Milwaukee, with bibles for those who are still incarcerated and backpacks for those coming out of incarceration. The backpacks go to women and men who have no one to assist them with their reentry. Inside the backpack, we supply a blanket, hygiene kit, a couple pairs of socks, information cards of where to go for services, a journal, pen, and a Pick 'N Save gift card to either purchase a bus pass or food, along with prayer cards to strengthen their faith in God.

I want to thank all of you for your prayers for the incarcerated and their families along with the financial assistance that you give to this ministry. Deacon Information Session

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee Office of Diaconate Formation will be holding an information session at St. Sebastian, 5400 W. Washington Blvd, Milwaukee on Monday, July 26 from 6:00 - 7:00 pm. 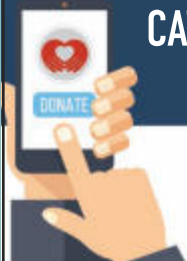
