

Pastor's Corner





On July 16th, we celebrate the Memorial of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. This year, because July 16th falls on a Sunday, the **Day of the Lord's** Liturgy takes precedence over the celebration of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. I wanted to make mention, however, of this beautiful memorial, especially

of the Collect Prayer that would have been said at the Mass for this feast day, namely,

"May the venerable intercession of the glorious Virgin Mary come to our aid, we pray, O Lord, so that, fortified by her protection, we may reach the mountain which is Christ."

I like the image of Christ as a mountain. I also realize how sweet and difficult it can be to climb it at times. Saint Therese of the Child Jesus well knew the task when she said, "I wish to find an elevator which would raise me to Jesus, for I am too small to climb the rough stairway of perfection." Full of compassion as he is, nevertheless, Jesus himself helps us reach the top of the mountain that he is. As saint Therese also said, "The elevator which must raise me to heaven is your arms, O Jesus!".

As I begin to celebrate the sacraments at the Cathedral, I have noticed that, to go from the sidewalk on Jackson Street - outside the main entrance - to the place where the altar is located, one has to "climb" a number of steps. The structure itself helps us keep in mind that our goal as Christians is to climb the mountain that is Christ by getting to know, love, and serve the Lord.

This Saturday, July 15th, the Cathedral will be opened for an event called *Oremus Milwaukee* from 7 p.m. until 10 p.m. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar, the top of the mountain. Then, people gathered to celebrate the *Bastille Days* and any of us who wish to participate, will be invited to go into the Cathedral church, light a candle and place it by the Blessed Sacrament near the altar. On Saturday, July 29th, we will have the same experience of silent adoration, this time at Saint Hedwig's Church on Brady street.

As we continue the journey towards Christ who is our destiny but also our companion and friend in the journey, I invite us to ask for the intercession of our Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, that we may keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, the Lord.
