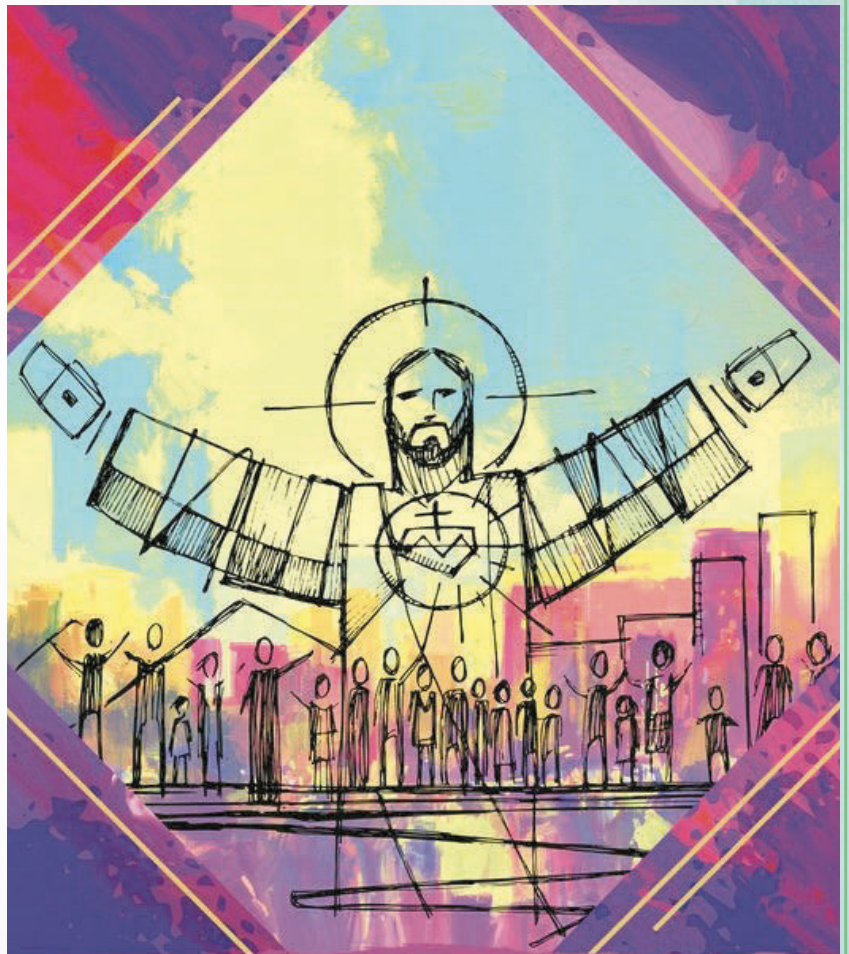

"I am the Way, the Truth, the Life." (Jesus Christ)

Dear Friends,

Our readings this Sunday set forth love as a process that engages us to the work for forgiveness, justice and peace in the midst of a world that is so used to doing things otherwise, where division, rancor, grudge, vengeance, ego happen in great and small ways.

It was no small mistake that from a very early point, following Christ was simply called following

"The Way."

To follow Christ is not to always get "your way," but to follow the way of Jesus, in self-surrender and unconditional love.

The Truth then is not mere knowledge or facts, but a Person, who by his example shows us the possibility of a life rooted in the Kingdom of God, a Kingdom of peace and justice.

The witness of the saints who really followed the Way gives remarkable evidence that those who lived by unconditional, self-surrendering love were gifted with amazing Life, not free from suffering or uncertainty, but happy in the fullest sense, that deep happiness which in the end, commitment to Christ grants in sweet mercy and kindness!

St. John the Evangelist, known as the Beloved Disciple, leaned close to Jesus' heart at the Last Supper. As we begin using the Day Chapel again, it will be referred to as the Sacred Heart Day Chapel, as we too, like our patron, seek to stay close to Jesus.
