

My job is Pillow Buyer and Supplier. We give out about sixty pillows a month. We are able to do this because of your cash donations. A clean, fresh pillow is a welcome gift for our neighbors in need. I am happy to do my part.

I either order online or go to Target or Walmart to buy pillows. If I order from Walmart, I get twelve, the maximum allowed. I recently noticed they have a "two-pack" option, now I get twenty-four at a time, which is all I can fit in the trunk of my car. When I am doing my regular shopping at Target, I fit as many pillows as I can in my cart, usually ten to twelve. I always get a comment or question from the cashier at Target as to why I am buying all those pillows. I am happy to share where the pillows are going. Thank you for your help.
