

"If he cries out to me, I will hear him; for I am compassionate.

Dear friends,

In the readings for this Sunday, we hear perhaps one of the most revelatory texts about who God is and the kind of heart he has. God has a tender, soft spot in his heart for the poor, and if anyone ever wrongs them, "I will surely hear their cry," says the Lord.

We are all poor, so in that way, we can all be sure that we are on God's good side. However, did I know that I was poor? Do I acknowledge my poverty, that is, my utter dependence on God for everything? "Blessed are the poor in Spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 5:3.)

Now, in some instances some people are called to a place of authority or that of a "higher rank," according to the labels that this passing world has created to structure groups of people and organizations.
