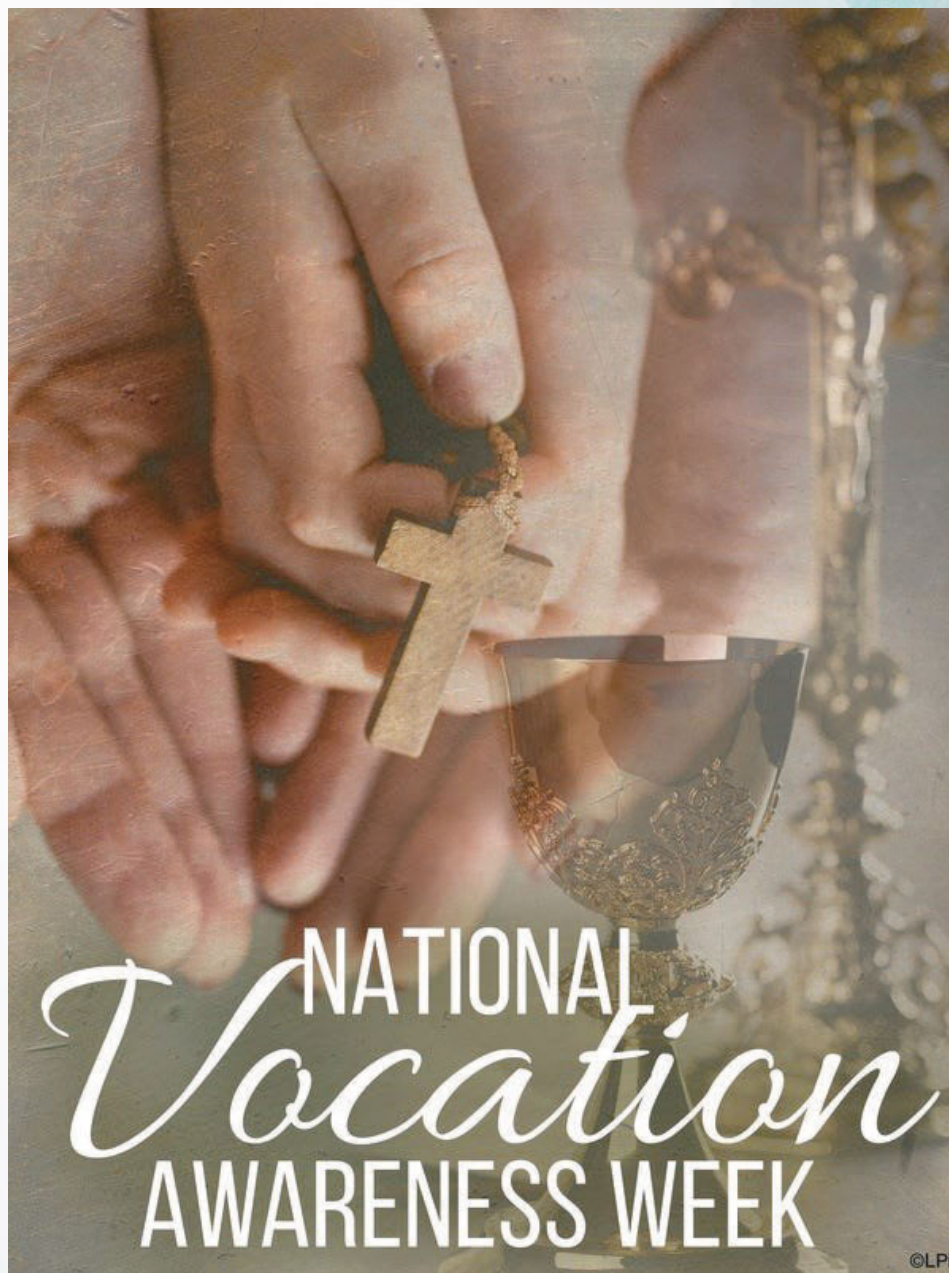

We are now in November, which is dedicated to the Souls in Purgatory. On November 2, we had All Souls Day — a day devoted to praying and offering Masses for the dead. The rest of the month is a continuation of the prayer. We are at the end of the liturgical year (the new year starts with the first Sunday of Advent). As the year comes to an end, we pray especially for our loved ones who died in the last year.

How can we pray for the dead? There are several ways.

First, have Masses offered for them, or you can offer their name at Mass in your prayers.

Second, we can visit a cemetery and pray, especially for those who have no one to pray for them.

Finally, pray a rosary for a family member or friend. All these prayers help fulfill the spiritual work of mercy of praying for the living and the dead.
