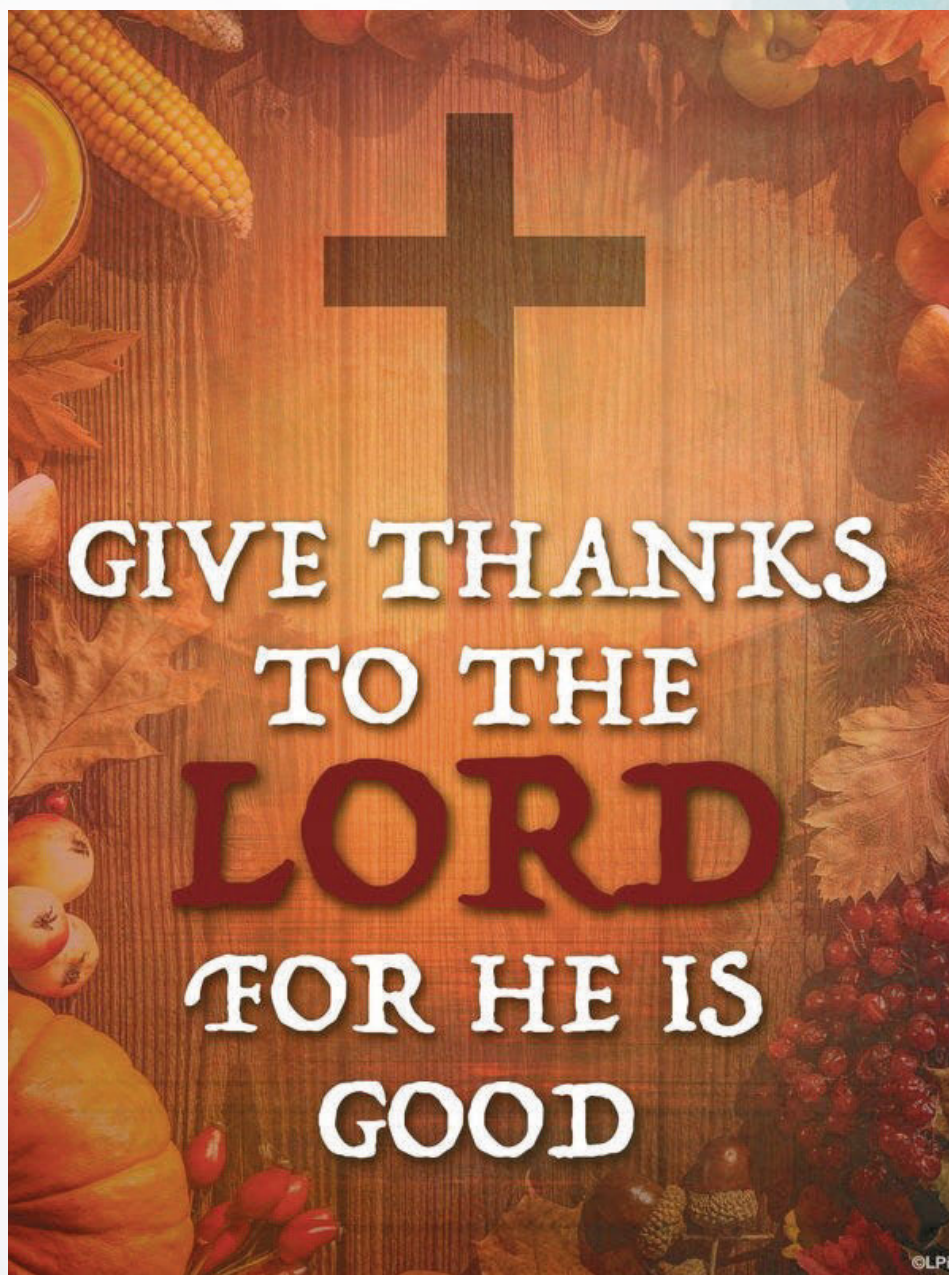

OPEN DOOR CAFÉ ITEM OF THE WEEK: SCARFS AND MITTENS

St. Vincent de Paul

The poor live all around us – even in our own neighborhoods. They are the families or individuals who live on a limited income. Sometimes they can pay their rent, utilities and phone bills, but have no money left for beds, appliances, food and clothing. They need help.

Saint Vincent de Paul makes a difference for them.

The home visit is the most basic activity of a Vincentian ministry. We go to the poor, always visiting in pairs. We listen to their perspective on the particular situation they are facing. When we are able, we try to meet immediate needs. This may be beds, household items or appliances. One of the most important gifts we can give is the feeling that someone cares, and that there is hope.

Jesus told us, "The poor will be with us always."

Put your faith into action. Serve those in need. You can do it! I invite you to join me on a home visit. The visit may last 15 to 30 minutes. Families we see have fled a domestic violence situation, been homeless, left a shelter or had a fire. We bring them household items, but sometimes we simply listen.

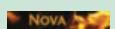

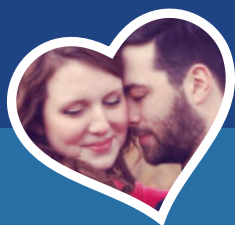
