

This weekend we are given a beautiful Advent image that fills us with much hope:

"Every valley shall be filled in, every mountain and hill shall be made low; the rugged land shall be made a plain, the rough country, a broad valley." (Isaiah 40:4)

"I make all things new" (Revelation 21:5) said the Lord. There is no reality that God cannot intervene and make new, even the most challenging ones.

Sometimes we witness with dismay the decisions of the powerful in the worldwide arena or at a more local, personal level. How much suffering comes out of the pride and thirst for power of a few!
