A World Full of Me?

There is a Seinfeld episode where Jerry meets a woman and they have everything in common. They eat the same foods, they laugh at the same jokes, and they like all of the same things. Jerry tells his friend Kramer that he has met the perfect woman because they are exactly alike. Jerry comes to the conclusion that he finally found what he has been looking for his whole life... himself! He goes on to say, "Now that I found me, I swept myself off my feet!" In the end, he ends the relationship because he remembers that he can't stand himself!

What this brings to my mind is what the world looks like if it was made up of people exactly like me; would it be nirvana, a train wreck, or something in between? One thing I know for sure is that it would not be complete. Even the best people I know aren't the best at *everything*. We need everyone to make the world complete.

St. Paul seems to clearly understand this when he writes that different spiritual gifts are given to different people. He knows that in order for the Holy Spirit to be fully alive in the world, it takes many people to say "yes" to the Spirit and then to share their gifts with others. It doesn't work if we all have the same gift. What really matters is that we recognize the gifts that we have and nurture them so that we are ready to contribute our gifts to the world.

So, what would the world look like if it was made up of people exactly like you? What would the world look like if everyone would readily share their gifts and talents with others to make it a better place? What are your gifts?




