



## *A New Reality*

During the Easter season, the disciples of Jesus have to get use to the new reality that Jesus is risen. For a number of years they followed Him, listened to His preaching and they were witnesses of his passion on Good Friday. Now they have to get used to the fact that Jesus is alive in a new and different way. They see Him, they experience Him and they come to the faith that he is alive. Different disciples experience the resurrection in their own way, for one the faith comes spontaneously and for another one more reluctantly, but they all come to the faith.



In our parish, we also have to adjust to the new reality of me leaving and Father James Baraniak coming. Last weekend I announced my resignation as pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes and the assignment of Father Jim as your new pastor. For me, this announcement was the last step in a process of discernment that started with my novitiate in 2017. I entered Saint Norbert Abbey because I wanted to see if religious life would work for me. As a diocesan priest living by myself, I had the longing to be part of a community, sharing life with others. My four years at Saint Norbert Abbey provided a good experience of community life. I appreciated some aspects of the common life like community prayer, community meals, and community recreation. However, at the same time, I felt that as a religious, I would be limited in my freedom. As I said in my announcement: "As a diocesan priest, I have grown accustomed to a level of autonomy and independence that is not possible in a religious community."

I am glad that I tried it, because otherwise I would never have known from an inside perspective how religious life in a community would be. However, it is with sadness that I leave Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Family. Since the beginning I have felt it was a good fit here. I know with Father Jim you have a good pastor at Lourdes and that makes leaving a little easier for me. In the coming months while I prepare for my departure to The Netherlands, we will still have time together to celebrate and to share our faith. Thank you for being kind and understanding in all of your responses.

Hereby last weekend's announcement:

I have some important news to share with you. Last week Bishop Ricken accepted my resignation as pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes, effective August 15. As some of you know I'm in simple vows with the Norbertines, which means that I'm still in a time of discernment. Four years ago, I entered the Norbertine community as a diocesan priest to discern if religious life in a community would work for me. The time at Saint Norbert Abbey gave me a good experience of religious life and through this, I realized that this way of life is not what I am called to.



As a diocesan priest, I have grown accustomed to a level of autonomy and independence that is not possible in a religious community. My departure from Our Lady of Lourdes comes with the decision to not make Solemn Vows with the Norbertines. Leaving all of you at Our Lady of Lourdes brings much sadness for me. I really love this parish family, and I have truly appreciated the time with you. As I am still a priest of the diocese of Utrecht in The Netherlands, the Cardinal Archbishop has instructed me to return to my home diocese. After I return to The Netherlands, I will be assigned as a pastor in the Archdiocese of Utrecht.

I fully realize my decision brings another major change for the parish. It is difficult to have so many changes in leadership in a short number of years. At the same time, Our Lady of Lourdes has been blessed to always have a priest, because that is not guaranteed in today's time.

Thankfully Abbot Radecki and Bishop Ricken were able to assign a new priest to Our Lady of Lourdes. Starting August 15, Fr. Jim Baraniak will be assigned as your pastor. Those of you who are longtime parishioners will remember Fr. Jim as the associate with Fr. Conrad Kratz and as a key member of the team that built this church. Currently Fr. Jim serves as the House Superior of the Norbertine House of Studies in Chicago. Thank you very much all for your trust and support to over the last two years.
