



Bob and Shaun, congratulations to both of you and your families in particular and to the whole Parish Family in general! It is a joy to have you both assigned here at Our Lady of Lourdes!



I am happy to introduce you to Deacon Bob and Deacon Shaun:

Bob Summers has been a member at Our Lady of Lourdes for 6 years. He has been married to Mary for 36 years and they live in Wrightstown. Mary and Bob have two adult children, Katie and Andrew. Katie is also a member of OLOL, and many know her as our former parish secretary and current Young Adult Ministry Coordinator. Bob's wife, Mary, works for the Diocese of Green Bay as a Human Resources Assistant, and Bob works in Information Technology for the Oshkosh Area School District. Both Bob and Mary serve in various ways at the parish. As part of his new role in the parish, Bob will be working with Baptism Preparation and Adult Faith Formation. We find the origins of the diaconate in Acts 6, which reads: "Now at this time, as the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint developed on the part of the Hellenistic Jews against the native Hebrews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily serving of food. So the twelve summoned the congregation of the disciples and said, "It is not desirable for us to neglect the word of God in order to serve tables. Instead, brothers and sisters, select from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task. But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." The announcement found approval with the whole congregation; and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch. And they brought these men before the apostles; and after praying, they laid their hands on them."

As the apostles laid their hands on Stephen, Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, Bishop Ricken laid his hands on Bob and Shaun, and he prayed over them. As ordained ministers, Bob and Shaun are going to serve the church of Green Bay in ministries as servants of the poor and the needy, as servants of the Word and the Altar. Bob and Shaun, it is with joy that we receive you in our midst as newly-ordained deacons. You are a sign that the church is alive and that people are willing to dedicate themselves to Christ and his Church.

Bob and Shaun, on behalf of the parish family, I wish you joy and fulfillment in your ministry here at Our Lady of Lourdes!


