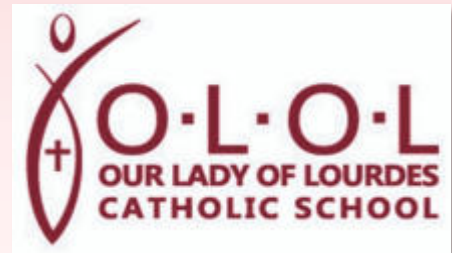
Parent Back-to-School Night was last week. Parents were able to sign-up for different breakout sessions that focused on different areas of OLOL. I would like to thank the parents that attended.
