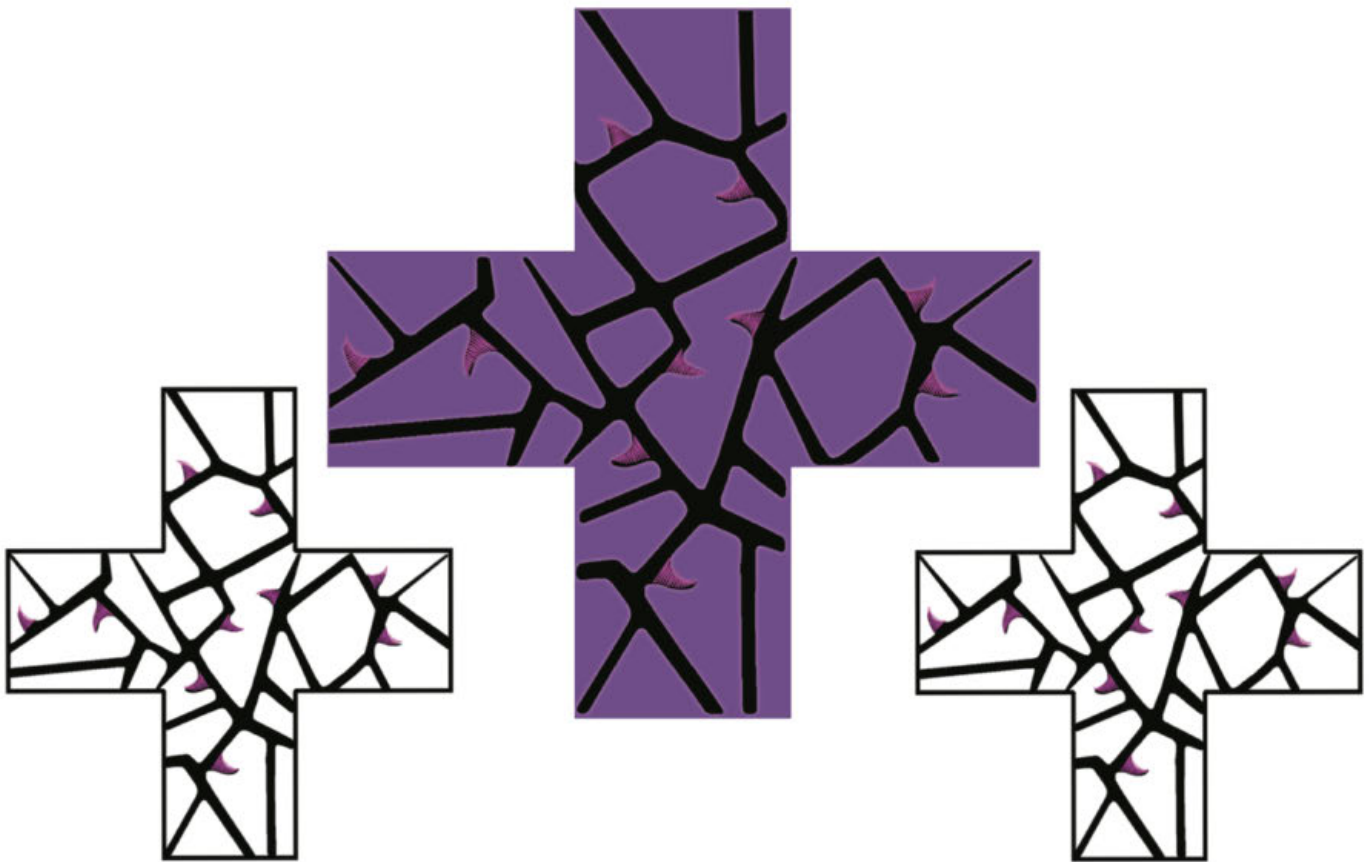

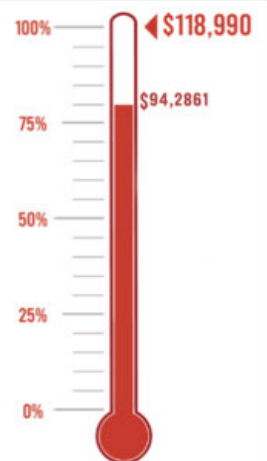

Growing in Relationship with God

This weekend, our Gospel could be described as a “pre-internet” version of “Cancel Culture.” (A form of ostracizing someone on social media). The woman brought before Jesus is already convicted by the public. The Pharisees and scribes have seen to it. They drag this woman through the street and up to Jesus not just to cancel her (because of her sin)...but to cancel Jesus as well. The Pharisees were trying to put Jesus in a no-win situation. If He shows leniency to the woman, Jesus would be accused of taking Moses’ law too lightly. His followers would hear Him and simply leave. If Jesus calls for her stoning, the people that were with Him would have surely picked up stones and killed her. And then the Jewish leaders would report him to the Romans for inciting her death (something that the occupying Romans ruled as something only they could do). Either answer and the Pharisees and scribes get to “cancel” Jesus out.



But Jesus doesn’t take the bait. He turns it back on them. He simply states that they are right to convict, but the jury and the executioners have to be without sin. And He remains silent. Drawing in the sand. Waiting for their own words to sink in. He knows that the crowd will have no choice but to walk away.

Are we any different today than the Pharisees or scribes in this story? Do we look at some people and judge their worthiness to be in our church? Are we hung up on our interpretation of God’s law to determine who is welcome in our pews? Laws or rules we don’t say out loud or necessarily consciously think about. Do we judge with questions like: “What if strangers come into our church?” “What if they don’t look like us?” “What if they don’t dress like we think they should?” “What if they don’t meet our definition of a family?”, or “What if their sins are somehow greater than our own?”

Jesus makes us realize this weekend that we can’t measure the height of our holiness by standing on the sins of others. Someday, we all will be brought before the Lord, and each of us will carry our own sins to be judged. Will we be as eager, then, to have Jesus throw the first stone?

We need to change our hearts. The Church is calling us to get ready for the great post-pandemic return. We have seen a return in our congregation as people want to be back and part of something bigger: to get to know Jesus. It is an exciting time. But are we ready to do this? Or will we get hung up on our rules and grab a stone?

We need to be the Church, the parish, that gives the opportunity for everyone to really come to know Jesus. But it will require a change in us, the people in the pews. We need to be ready to greet people into our church as they are. We need to smile and welcome them in. The words “All are Welcome” needs to be evident in our actions. Let’s take this opportunity to pick up our rocks. But instead of throwing them at others to cancel out others, let’s put them together in a pile and continue to build God’s Church—our parish—one person at a time.

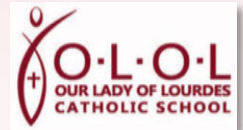

Walk to Mary

Participants start with St. Joseph (at the National Shrine of St. Joseph) and walk to Mary (at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help) to get to Jesus. The annual pilgrimage has impacted lives and filled hearts with many blessings from the Holy Family.

The 21-mile walk spiritually prepares us for the destination - America's only Church-approved Marian apparition site, where in 1859, the Blessed Mother appeared to Adele Brise on the site of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help in Champion. To register, please visit walktomary.com

Catholic Relief Services

Thank you for your support of the World's Poor Collection last weekend. One of the beneficiaries was Catholic Relief Services (CRS). Below is more information about how CRS is helping those in Ukraine.

CRS continues to support 65 Caritas offices throughout Ukraine—all but two are still open and providing relief—serving more than 167,000 displaced Ukrainians with food, hygiene supplies, shelter and trauma counseling.

As families flee the country, ongoing donations mean that families entering Moldova, Poland and the surrounding countries receive resources immediately. Your support means so much to families like Victoria's, who left her hometown Cherkasy to Poland—more than 400 miles away—with her three children, Alina, Alisa and Vladislav.

In Moldova, CRS is preparing beds, hot meals and hygiene supplies for up to 20,000 refugees in temporary placement centers.

In Romania, five CRS-supported border centers organized by Caritas Romania are hosting hundreds of people in transit every night.

In Poland, Caritas Poland continues to receive refugees at the border while CRS helps build a cash distribution program to serve hundreds of thousands in need. The Caritas cross-border hub located in Poland—and supported by CRS—is organizing meal kits for distribution by Caritas partners inside Ukraine. The initial order will provide at least 80,000 kits.

This war is heartbreaking. We really have no words to describe it. But we are on the ground responding as quickly as we can.

"For Those Who Server" Scholarship

Thanks to the generosity of a parish family, we have a "For Those Who Server" scholarship to offer to high school seniors who are pursuing post secondary education. Applicants for this scholarship must be parishioners of Our Lady of Lourdes who have shared their time and talents as Mass servers or in other ministries that support the Mass (lectors, ushers, greeters, musicians, etc.).
