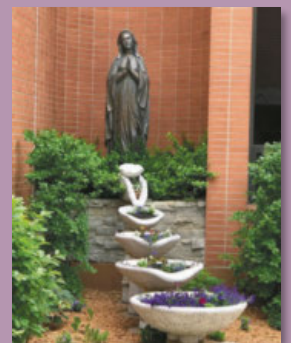

Recycling Event

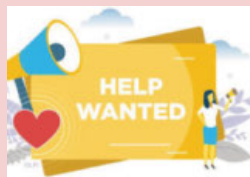

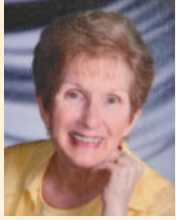
