He was selfish and never gave to the poor. Everything changed for him when he was consecrated Archbishop of Canterbury. He gave away his possessions and welcomed the poor to his table.

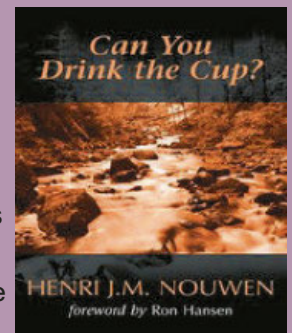


"Can You Drink the Cup?"

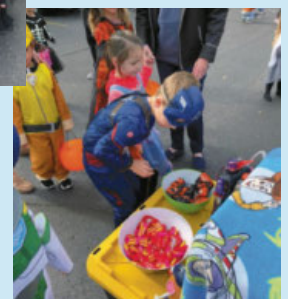

Christmas is Coming!

For the past four years, our church has helped the De Pere Christian Outreach Christmas Store provide items for our De Pere low-income/at risk families to have a Merry Christmas.

For new parishioners and others who may be unaware of this program, let us explain:

Families are chosen to shop (based on their financial need) by the social workers of the East De Pere, West De Pere, and Syble Hopp Schools. Families are able to purchase new clothing, household items, and toys at rummage sale prices. It has been found that parents would rather work and pay for items they get. This instills pride and dignity in the families we help. The money received is then used to purchase additional items for the store.

Last year the Christmas Store provided gifts for 160+, which included 275 adults and 426 children.

Here's how you can help. Christmas trees are in the Gathering Area with tags requesting items that are needed to stock our store. All items must be new. Please take one or more tags, purchase the requested items, and return them to the boxes in the Gathering Area by November 21.
