Three Days that Changed the World

I'll start us out with a joke before I get serious about Palm Sunday and Holy Week. One Palm Sunday, a little boy had a sore throat and had to stay home from church with a sitter. When the rest of the family came home, they were carrying palm branches. The little boy asked what they were for. His father told him that people held them over Jesus' head when he walked by. In a sad, disappointed voice, the little boy said, "Wouldn't you know it? The one Sunday I miss, Jesus shows up!"

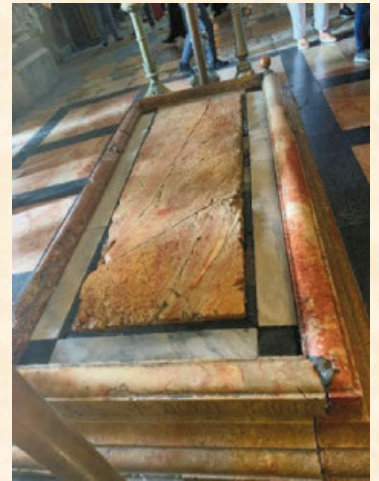
Now I'll transition to the 3 days that changed the world. The first picture is one that I took at Calvary, the actual site of Station 12-- Jesus dies on the cross. It still makes me emotional. The second picture is me on a path that is preserved because they know that Jesus actually walked there. The final picture is the Stone of Uncion, upon which Jesus' body was laid and prepared for burial.

Having had the abundant blessing of traveling to the Holy Land this past October with other pilgrims (friends) from our parish, Holy Week this year is more powerful than ever. I recall stopping on the road that Jesus walked on Palm Sunday, I wanted to absorb the magnitude of the place that I was in. Walking the Stations of the Cross in Jerusalem enhanced my life and leading the Living Stations of the Cross with our students (with Nicole Gerbers as our director), the vastness of what Jesus did for me, for each of us, comes full circle.

Again this year, from 4 pm on Holy Thursday until 4 pm on Good Friday, our students will be participating in a 24-Hour Food Fast. We know that fasting and prayer can help us hear God more clearly. Our students will be attending Holy Thursday Mass and Good Friday Service. They will also participate in Adoration. Will you keep us in your prayers? We will be praying for you. Please consider fasting (from your home) along with us. Saint John Chrysostom said that "Fasting of the body is food for the soul."
